

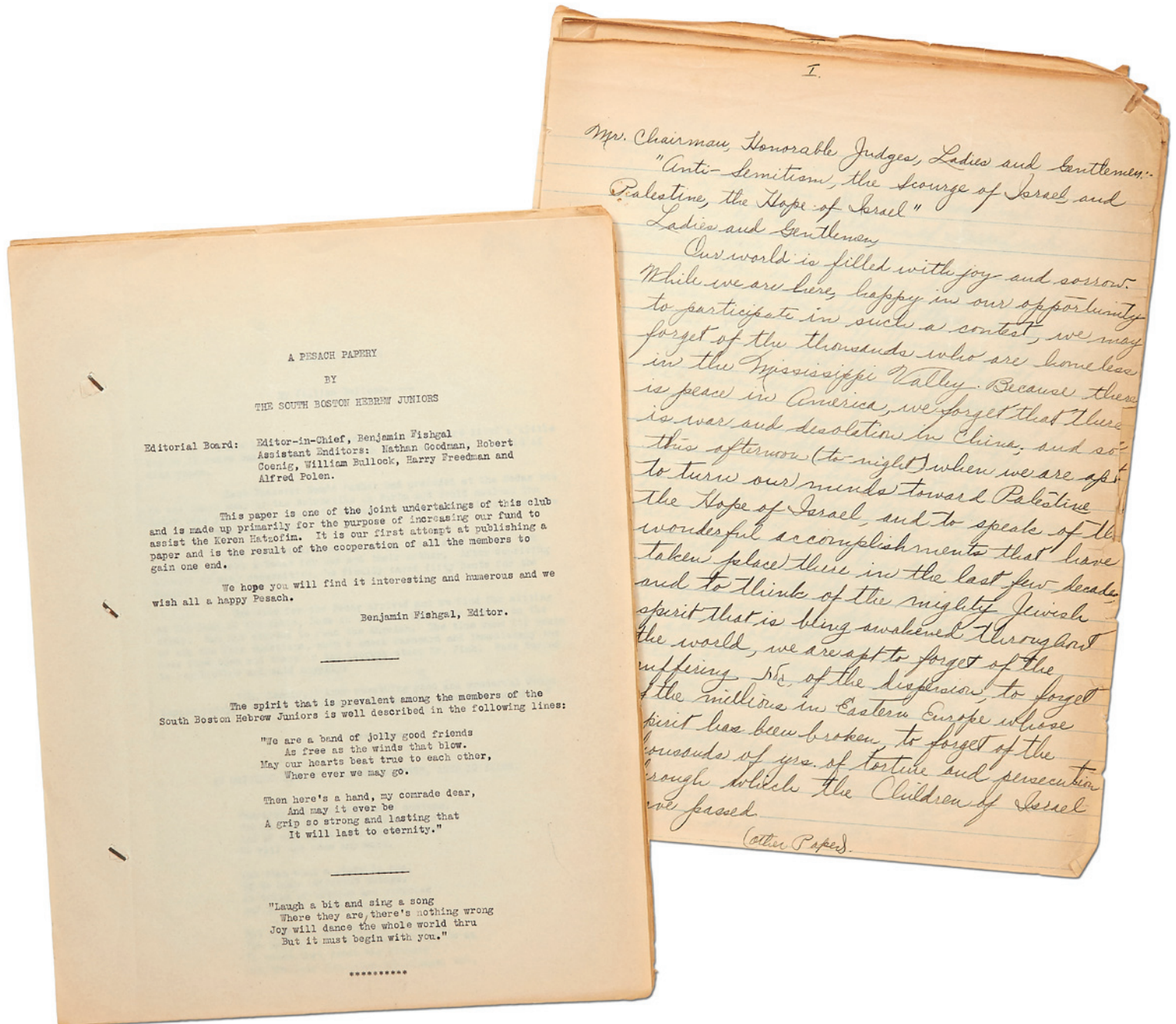

Made-up of various short pieces relating to the club, including an original poem, and a jest about how to become an American citizen. Laid-in is a six page manuscript essay (on six ruled sheets), presumably written by one of the club's young members: "Anti-Semitism, the Scourge of Israel; and Palestine, the Hope of Israel." References are made to the: "thousands who are homeless in the Mississippi Valley, "war and desolation in China," and to the "millions in Eastern Europe whose spirit has been broken..." No known copies. A compelling, scarce survival.
