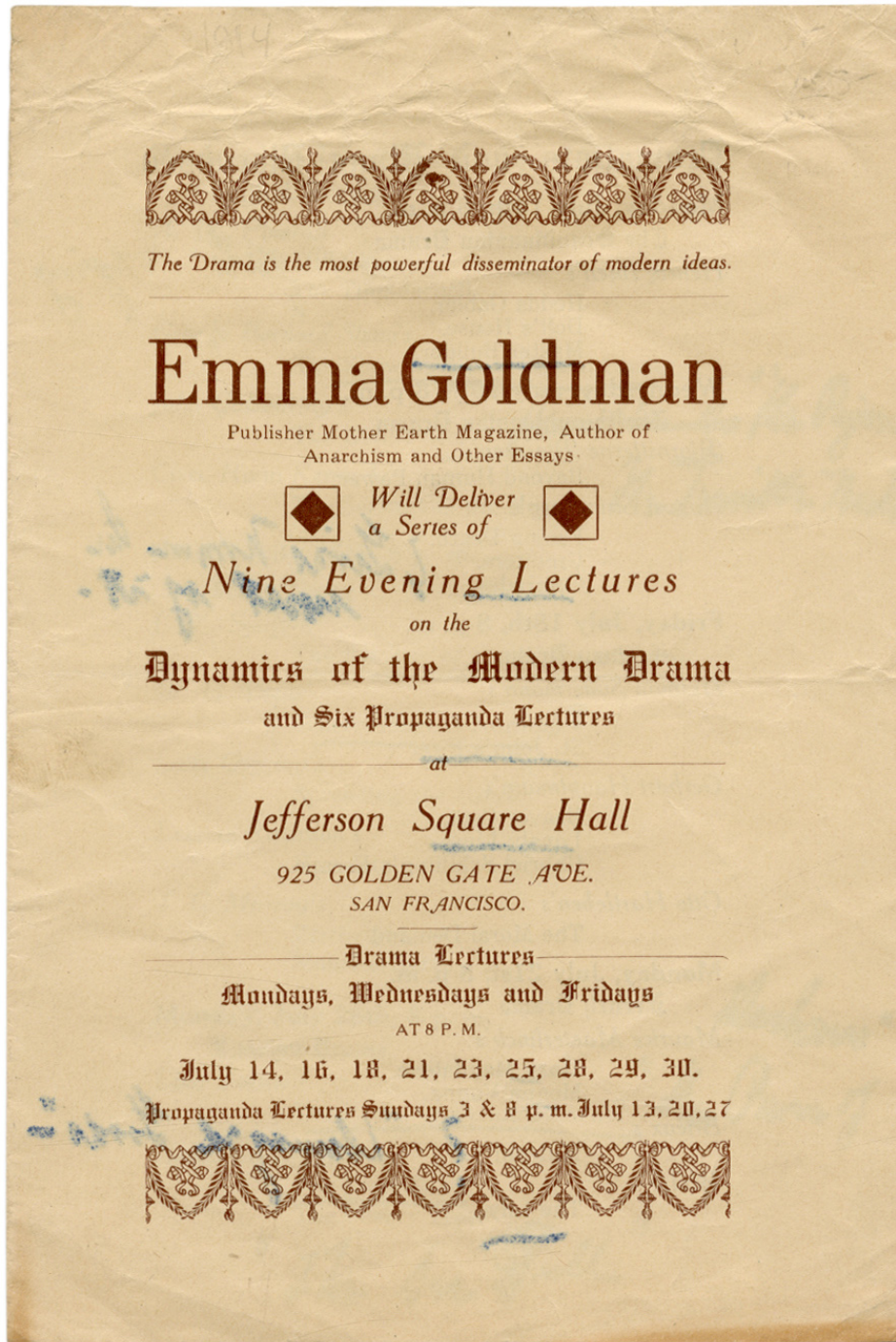

Program. One leaf folded to make four pages. Some ink notes in the text of unknown origin resulting in some modest bleed through, faint horizontal crease, very good condition. A program from one of the radical anarchist's lecture tours, first treating with the drama of the Scandinavians, French, Germans, English, and Irish, and culminating, not surprisingly with the Russians. More interesting are her "Propaganda Lectures" on subjects "The Social Evil" (apparently on venereal disease and sexual exploitation) and "The Relation of the Individual (sic)". An early owner has corrected and annotated the program in ink, evidently wherever Goldman deviated from the published program, a few titles of plays are underlined, another title Brieux's "Damaged Goods" (a venereal disease problem play) is added in the margin, as is another Tolstoy play. This tour resulted in Goldman's arrest (along with Ben Reitman) in San Diego where they were taken to the police station, surrounded by a mob, and subsequently escorted and placed on a train to Los Angeles "for their own safety". Goldman's free speech fight in San Diego was a notable event in anarchist activity of the period. *OCLC* locates no copies. [\[BTC#390474\]](#)
