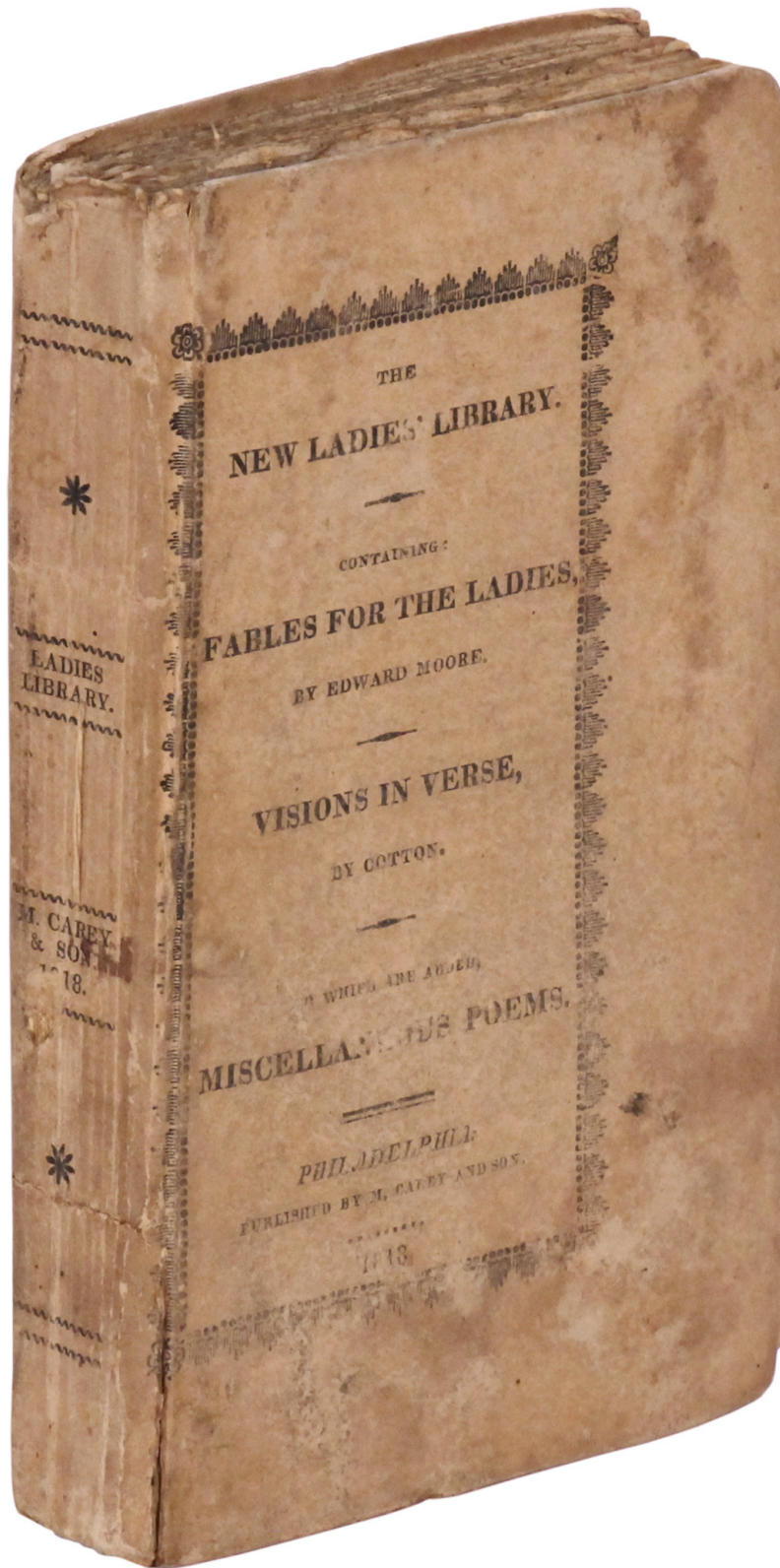

Ownership signature of Samuel G. Wright an important early American merchant and entrepreneur, for whom the New Jersey town Wrightstown is named.
