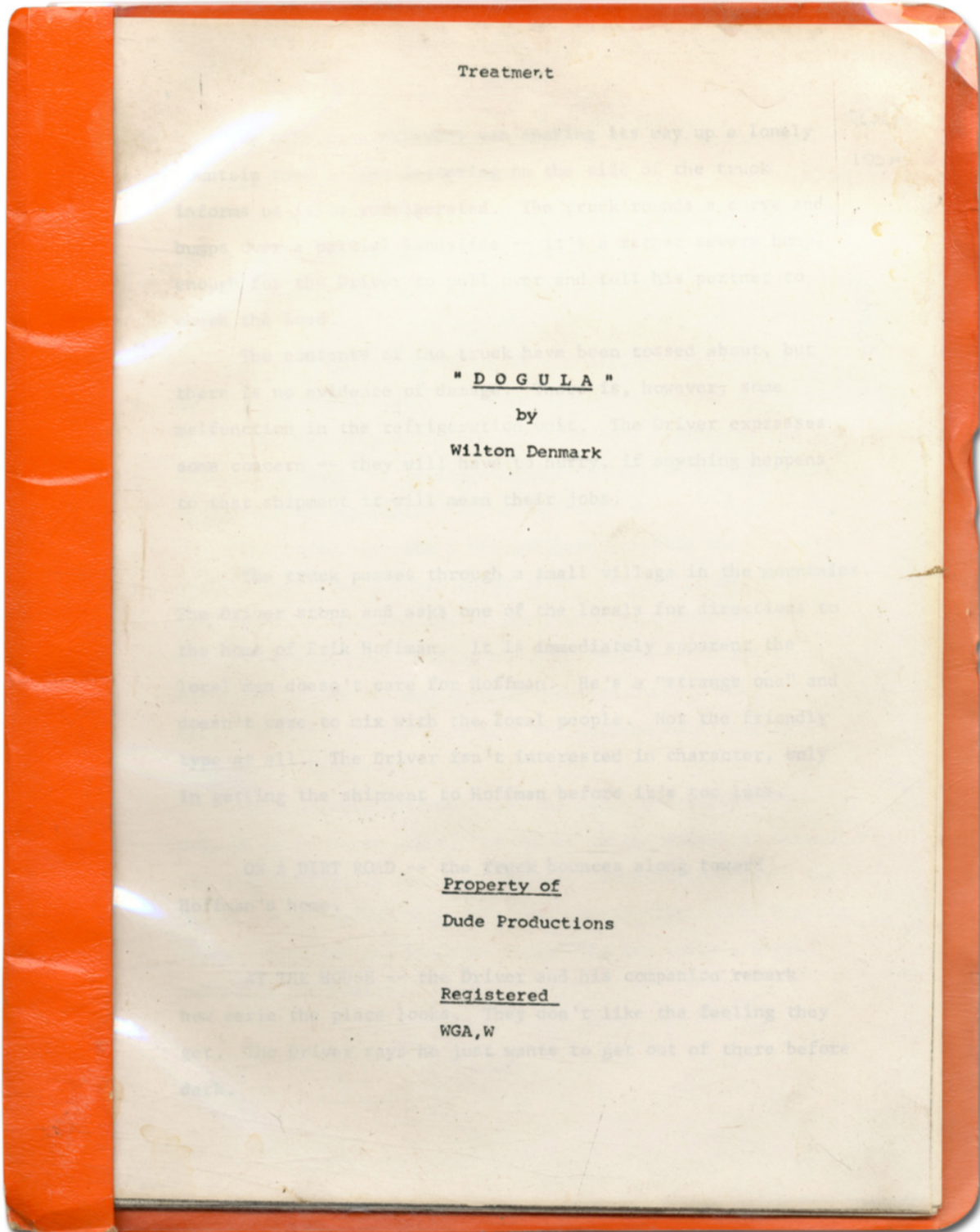

Photocopied pages brad-bound into velux and card binder. 28pp. Modest wear, very good or better. A treatment (or prose synopsis) for an unproduced horror film about a vampire dog. Inadvertently transformed by a scientist who has successfully resurrected a vampire and turned himself into one in the process, Bruno (or Dogula, as he becomes known) terrorizes the local villagers and becomes the quarry of the local sheriff and national guard: "...the more Dogula is wounded, the more blood he requires. He just can't be killed." Lured into a trap by the scent of blood, Dogula is seemingly destroyed in napalm blast – or is he? Wilton Denmark was a California screenwriter whose credits include *Fantasy Island*, *Wonder Woman*, and *The Six Million Dollar Man*. He also wrote the screenplay for the 1971 film *Cain's Cutthroats*, directed by Ken Osborne and starring John Carradine and Scott Brady. Alas, *Dogula* was unproduced, and presumably nothing of it remains but this treatment. OCLC locates no copies. [BTC#391440]
