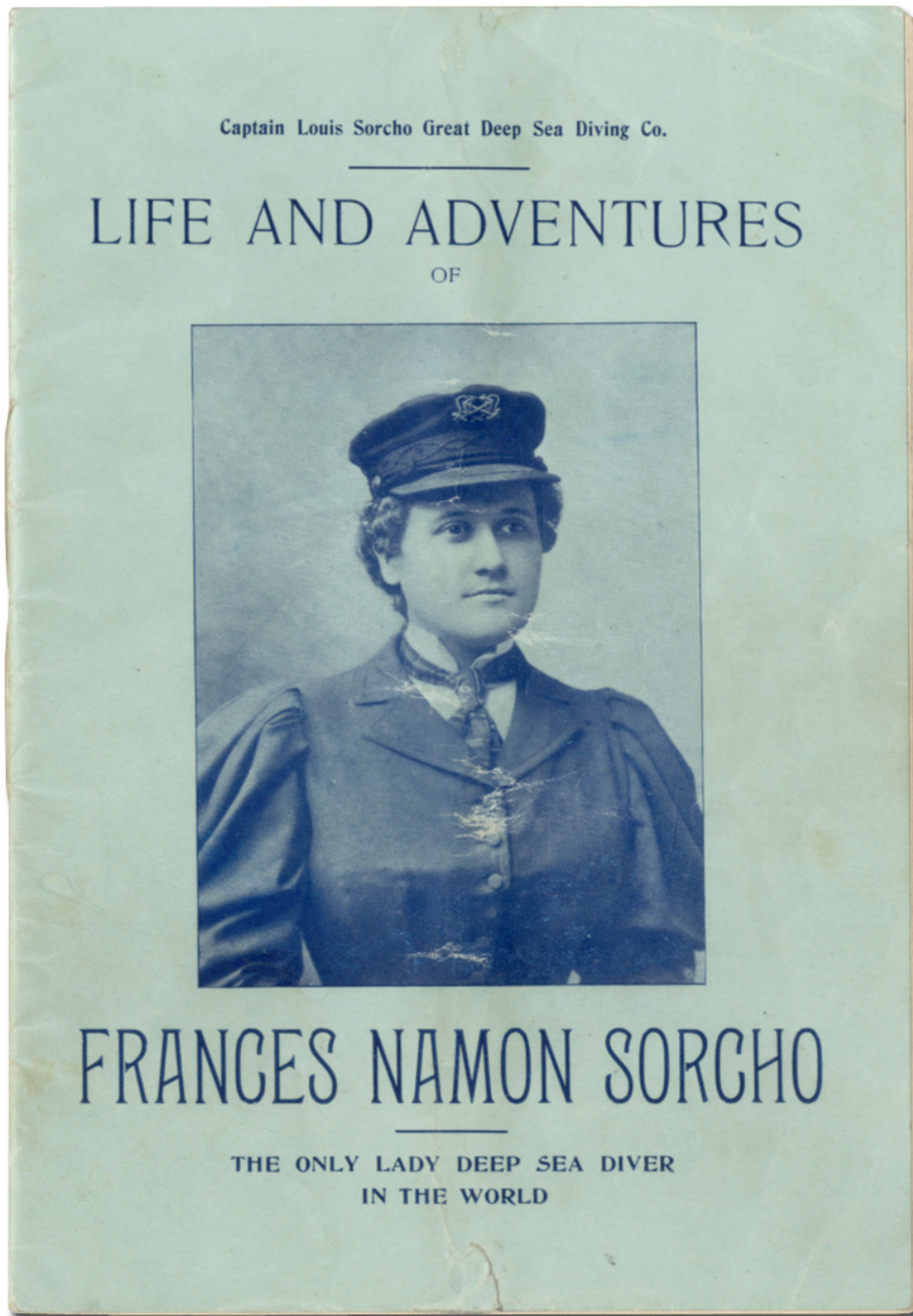

Exceptionally scarce pamphlet that explains how Mrs. Sorcho became a diver, and relates her feats, it begins with a poem by her, and includes a photograph of her in diving gear. Frances Namon became a diver when she married Louis Sorcho, who later claimed to have recovered 139 bodies from the wreck of the U.S.S.
