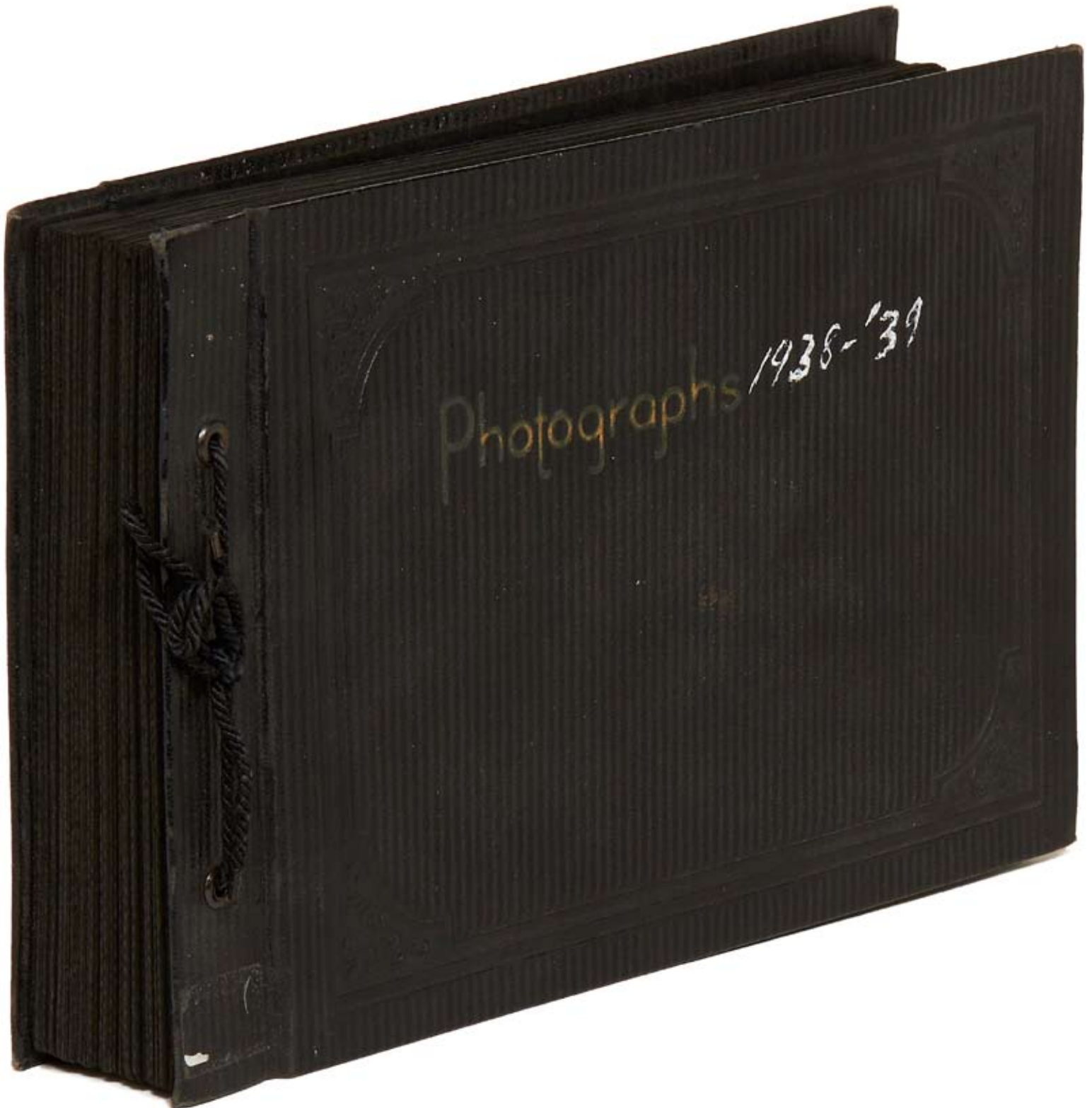

A collection of photographs taken of the new members of the American Chemical Society for the years 1938-1939 with the name of each member listed below the photo. Beginning at the College of Pharmacy of the City of New York in 1876, the American Chemical Society, or ACS, was an assembly of 35 like minded scientists who wanted a forum within they could share findings with each other and the American public and to separate themselves from more general organizations, like the American Science Society, so they could focus "directly on theoretical and applied chemistry." By the 1930s the society had grown to "18,206 members, 83 local sections and 17 disciplinary divisions." An interesting accumulation of the fresh faces of chemistry in the early half of the 20th century.
