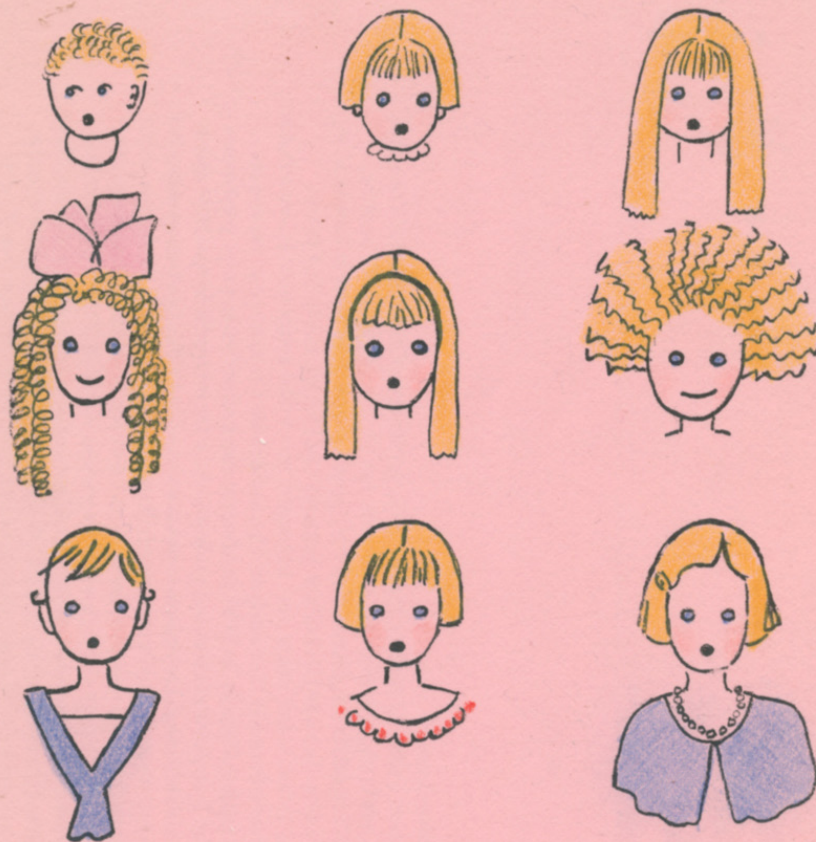

Infirm owner's name inside front cover, slight sunning, easily fine. Autobiography of Elizabeth Parker Kase (1913-2008) from birth to age 12. She was born in Pasadena and died in Montecito. During her youth she lived in Pasadena and in Arizona, where her father managed cotton ranches for Goodyear Tire and Rubber Company in support of the war effort in World War One. She later returned to Pasadena, attended Mills College and UCLA. She spent most of her life in Pasadena where she pursued art.
