Jottings from Overland Trip to Arizona and California 1908

First edition. Small octavo. 99pp., illustrations from photographs. Gray wrappers printed in green. Very slight sunning on wrappers, else fine. The author and a schoolmate, Adina M. Gidley, went West on the railroad, with a substantial visit to Bisbee, Arizona, where they tour the Holbrook Mine, about a third of the book devoted to Bisbee and the Mine. Cole traveled on to Castroville and Pacific Grove, California, and later visits Monterey, Santa Cruz, the Big Tree Grove, Fresno City, Reedly, and then returns to New York. Provides excellent commentary on the locations visited. The book is touchingly dedicated to the author's "Beloved Nieces". Curiously, of 20 copies noted in *OCLC*, all but two are held in the far West. [BTC#395042]
