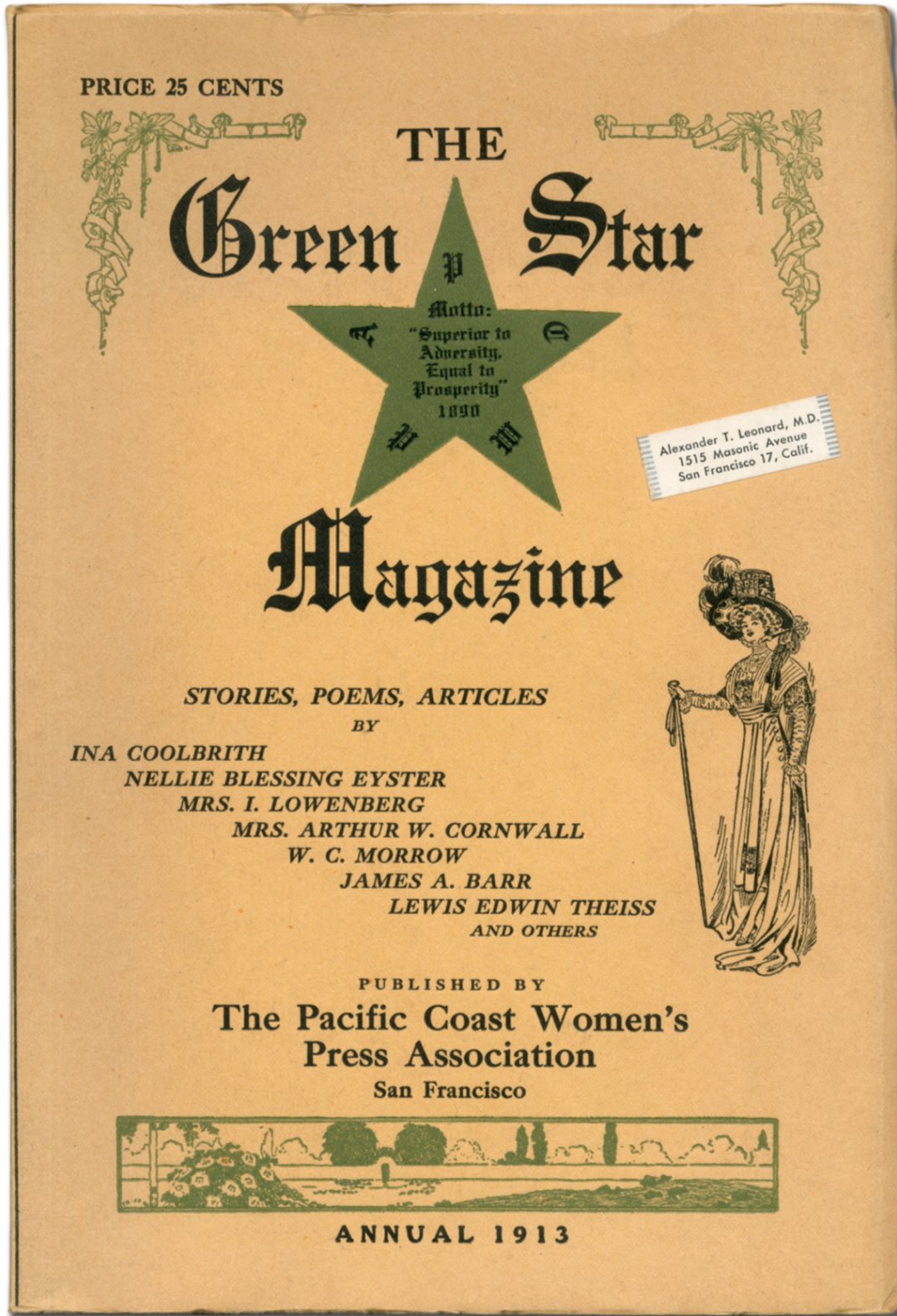

Tall octavo. 160, [8]pp. Illustrated printed wrappers. Owner's label on front wrap, else just about fine. Contributions almost exclusively by West Coast women including Ina Coolbrith, including poems, stories, and articles, most of a progressive nature. The only two articles obviously written by men (a few are signed only with initials and are difficult to identify) are *The Significance of Woman's Suffrage* and one by the Director of the Panama-Pacific International Exhibition of 1915, about that event, then in the planning stage. Intended as an annual, we aren't aware of how many were issued thus, or if indeed this was the only annual issue. OCLC locates five copies (four in California, the other at Brown).
