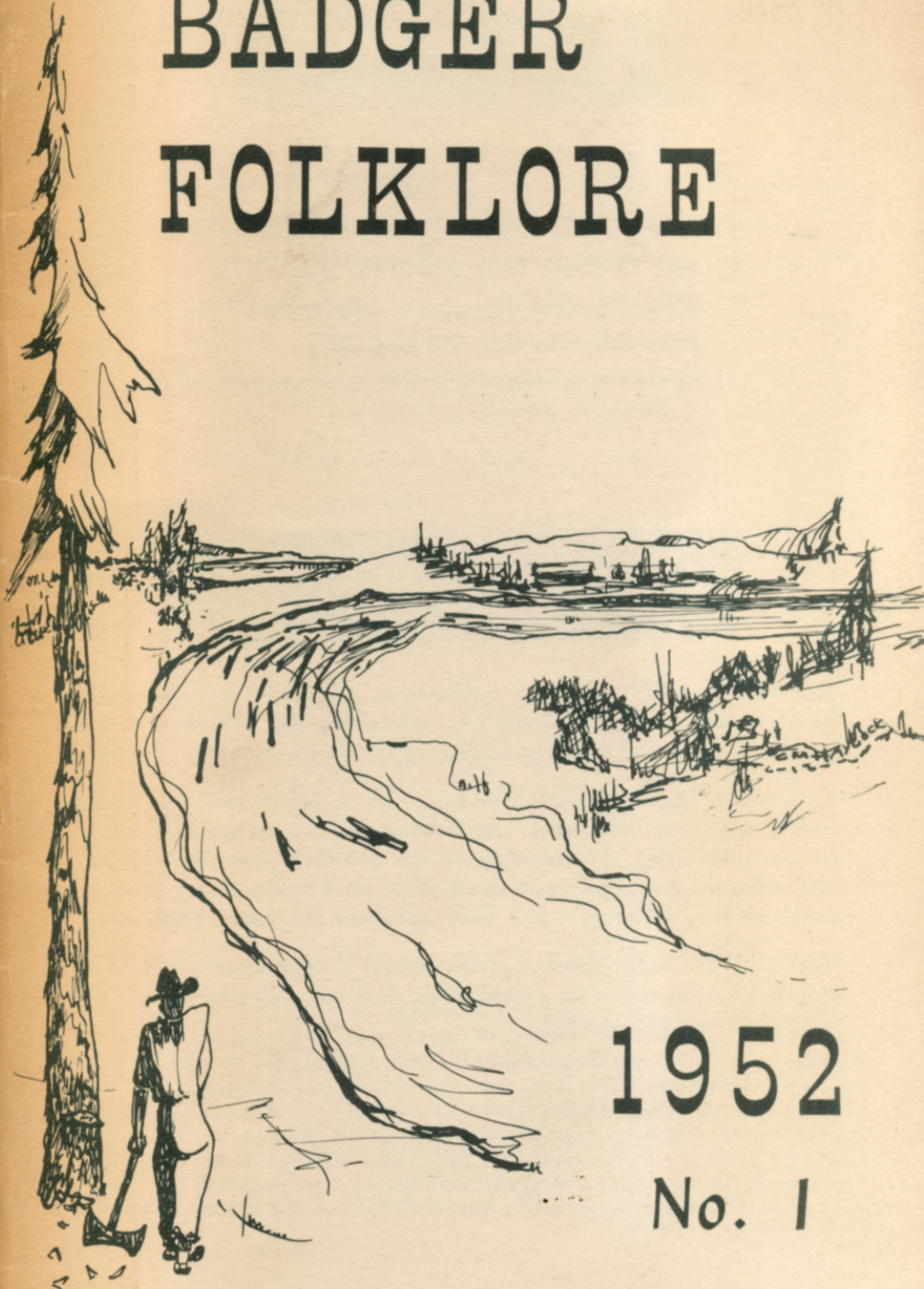

Octavo. 24pp., illustrated. Stapled illustrated buff wrappers. Issue of an irregularly printed journal, a fact acknowledged in the editor's notes: "Badger Folklore has had a year off..." Apparently printing began in 1948 but stopped, and re-started with this issue #1 in 1951, and again ceasing publication in either 1951 or 1952. A substantial portion of this issue is taken up with work by an Oneida, Andrew Beechtree, who includes a two-page letter, and a six-page Oneida legend titled "Oneida Genesis". The only other significant contribution is a glossary of "Logging Language" dealing with the patois of the lumberjack. *OCLC* locates two runs (NYPL and one in Newfoundland) without shedding much light on the actual breadth of publication.
