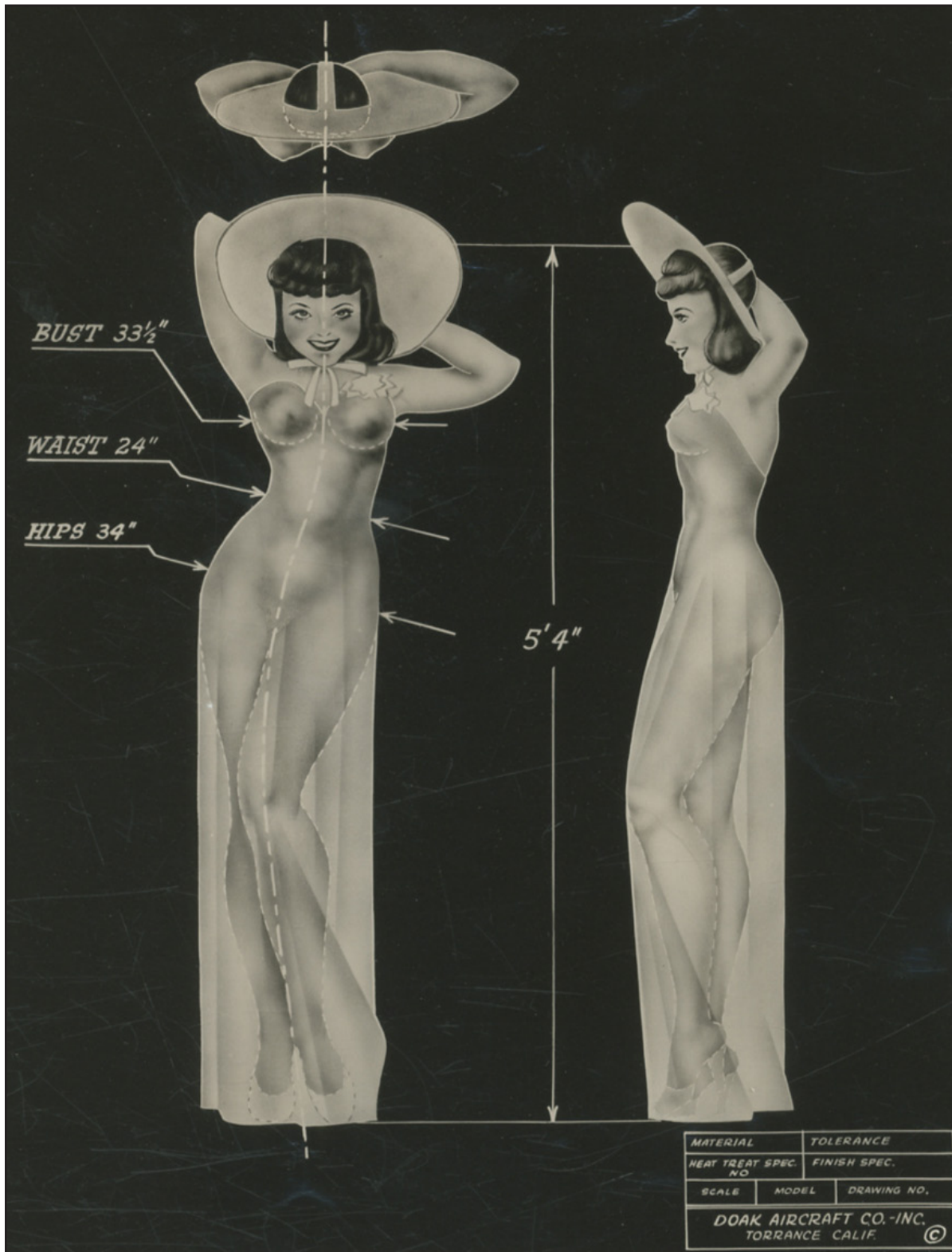


[Press Photo]: Burlesque Dancer Schematic

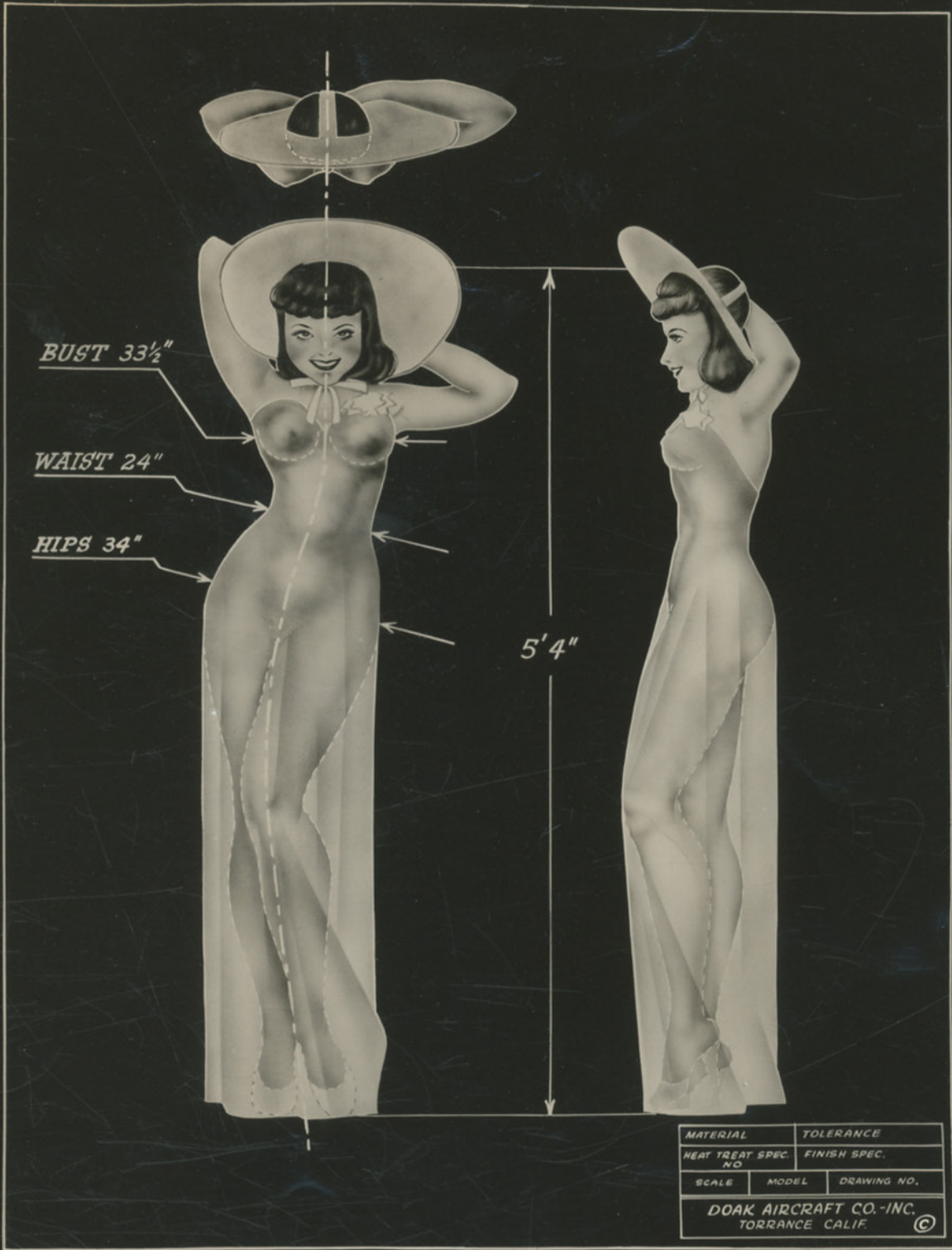
