

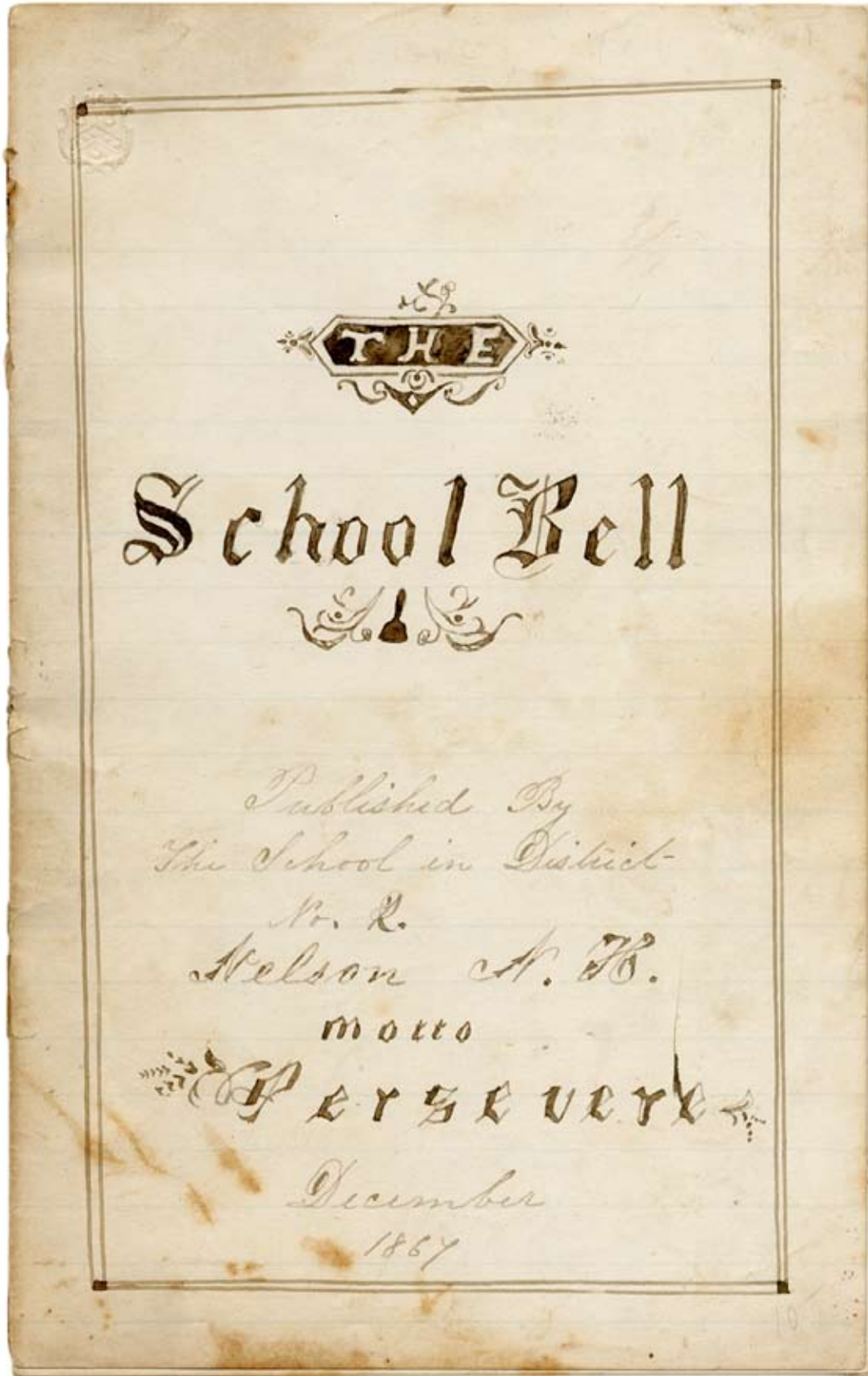

Few stains on the front wrap, small tears on the rear wrap, a bit of splittin g along the spine fold, the brown ink has faded overall but is readable, but overall sound and very good. Apparently started in 1867, but a number of later entries are dated in 1872. Among the titled handwritten articles are: Editorial, School Days, The Story of a Maple Tree, Auction Sale (of the estate of the possibly pseudonymous Jeremiah Sniffles), Scolding, and The Close of the Term. The final two pages are devoted to a letter about the school addressed to "Dear Friend." Nelson is a small town near the southwest corner of New Hampshire. An amusing bit of boyish tomfoolery, presumably prepared for the edification of its author. [BTC#399057]
