Large oblong quarto. [88]pp. Original decorative limp brown suede binding. Photo corners are used to attach the snap shots to the black album pages, which are annotated below in white ink. Small stain to the front cover of the album; otherwise the binding and contents are clean and bright. 315 original black-and-white photographs, the vast majority measuring 3½ x 2½ inches, filled with holographic captions and annotations. This album documents the life of a U.S. Navy nurse serving in Hawaii during the last two years of World War II. Although she did not write her name in the album, census and military records suggest it was compiled by Nellie Landes (b.1920), who began her medical training at Massillon City Hospital in Ohio, then studied at the Sampson New York Naval Training Center, before being assigned to the U.S. Naval Hospital in Aiea Heights, Oahu, Hawaii. A photo in the album is inscribed, "To Nellie and our friendship and all it can afford." Landes is also pictured in a photo with other nurses, which she labeled "Ohio nurses taken for public relations." [BTC#399182]
