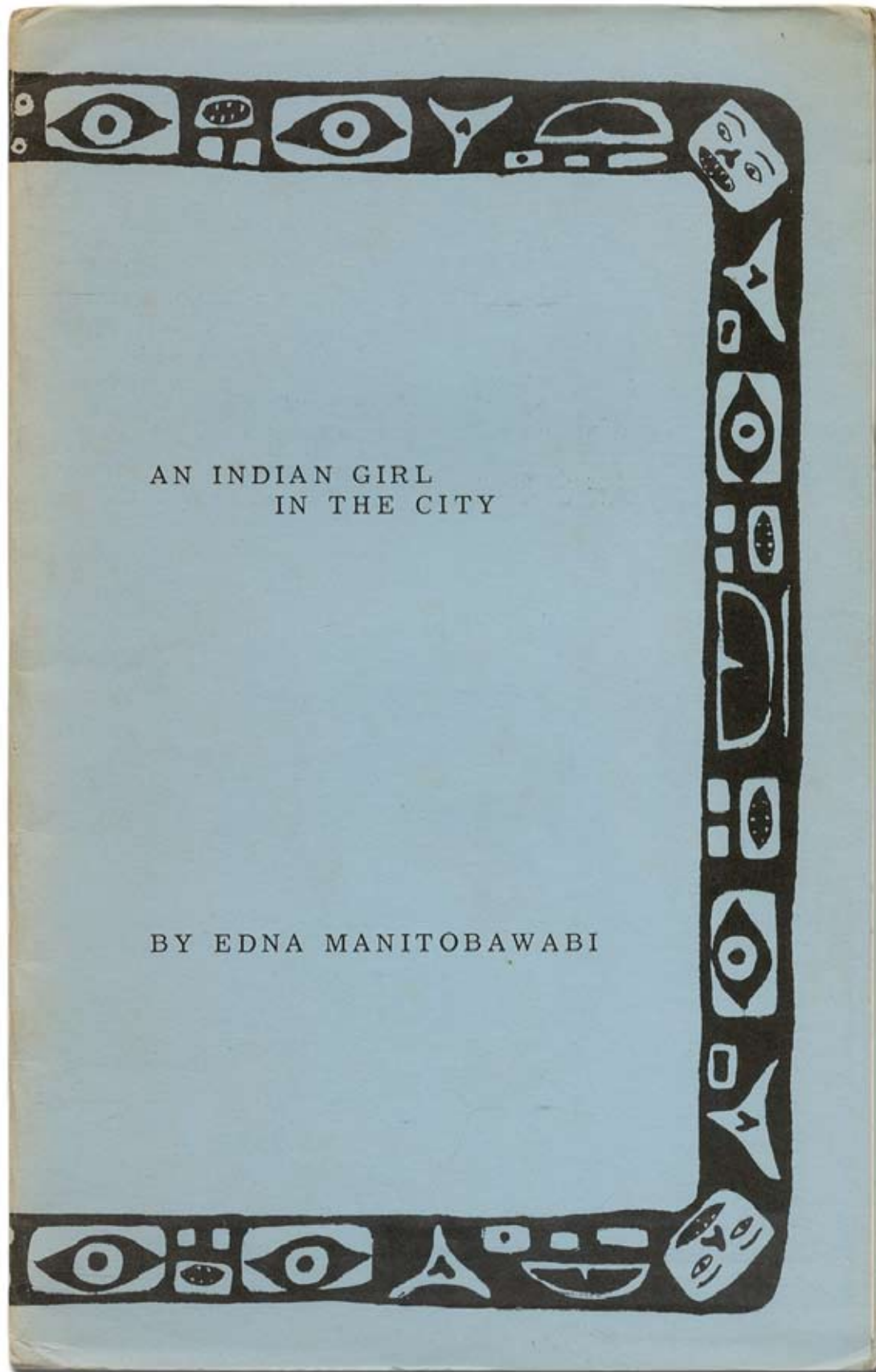

First edition (or first separate edition, a “slightly different version, originally appeared in: This Magazine is About Schools. Vol. 4, No. 4.”) Octavo. 17pp. Stapled decorated blue wrappers. Some age-toning at the thin spine, else very near fine. Contemporary autobiographical account of a young woman raised on the reservation, sent to Catholic boarding school, gets pregnant, drifts to New York, becomes depressed and suicidal, is hospitalized, and released. At the time this was written she was engaged to be married to an Ojibwa and is planning to move to Western Canada, where they want to join others to go back to the pre-reservation, “old ways.” [BTC#399193]
