

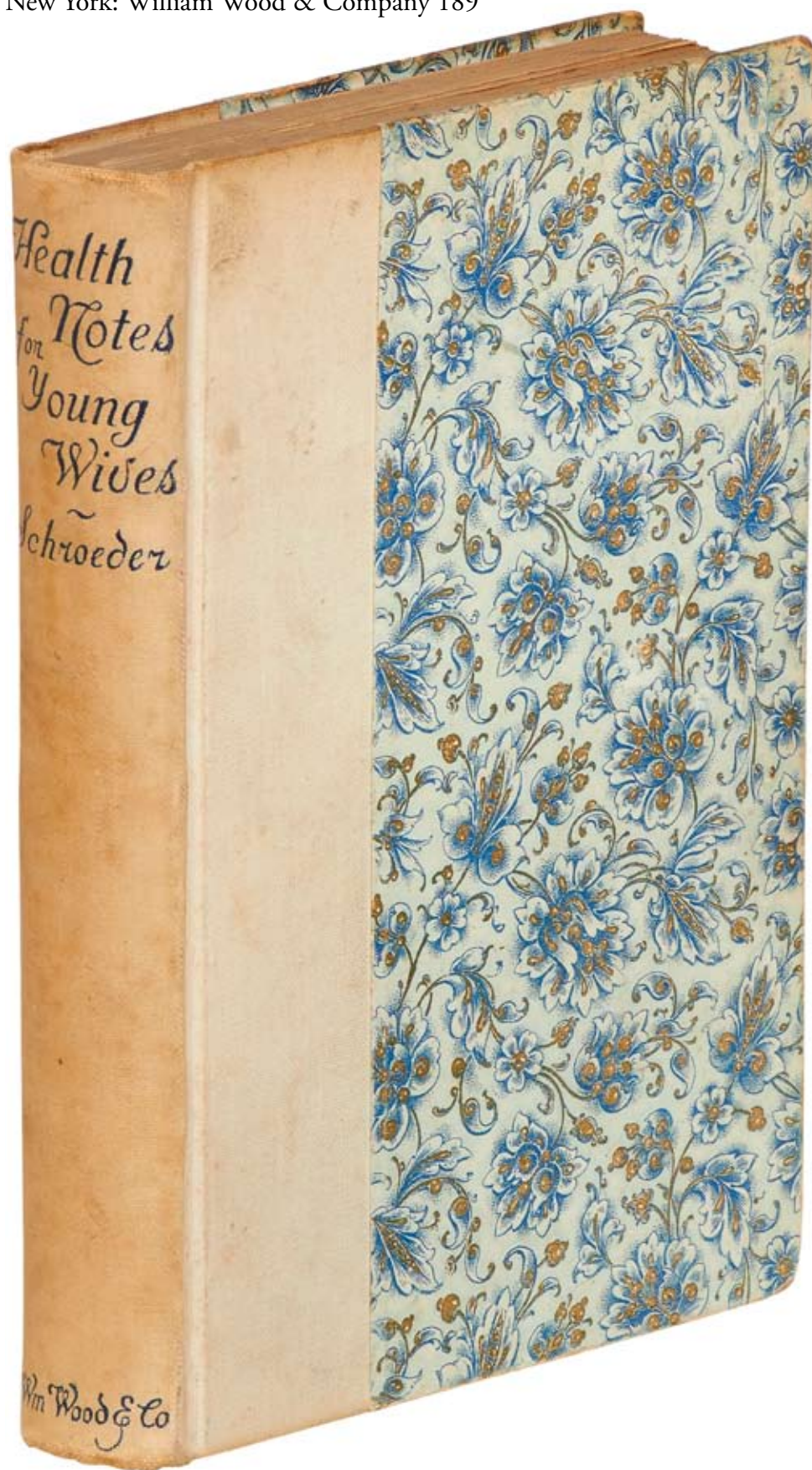

First edition. 12mo. 210pp. Half cream cloth stamped in green, and flowered paper over boards. Some rubbing on the boards, slightly cocked and soiled at the spine, very good or better. Overall medical advice for younger women largely centered on childbearing, unusual in that it sympathetically delivered by a female physician, Dr. Aimée Raymond Schroeder (1853-1903) who first practiced medicine in France and Italy but did not receive a formal degree before she received one from the Women's Medical College of New York (1889). Her father, Henry J. Raymond was the founder of the *New York Times* and was an early supporter of both Drs. Elizabeth and Emily Blackwell in their successful attempts to receive medical degrees. She was an editor of the *New York Medical Journal* and of the *American Journal of Obstetrics*.
