Quarto. Blue plastic photo album measuring 8" x 12" containing 177 color photographs measuring 3½" x 5" without captions. Also included are newspaper clippings and military ephemera. A collection of photographs from David Douglas while he was stationed with the U.S. Air Force Red Horse (Rapid Engineer Deployable Heavy Operational Repair Squadron Engineer) construction unit, the 820th Civil Engineering Squadron out of Nevada, in Honduras in the late 1980s to the early 1990s. Depicted are military vehicles and troops constructing a base near La Mesa, San Pedro Sula. Their deployment, according to a newspaper article found in the album, was to rebuild an airfield. Another clipping reads, "the Nellis squadron is in Honduras to build a cargo staging area that would be used to unload supplies during an emergency, such as an invasion." Pictured throughout the album are the men of the 820th in camps, on site, and on the coast. Also included are Douglas' I.D. badge, a handwritten poem, and a card in English and Spanish asking for help in the case of an emergency. [BTC#399321]

## Congress OKs Drug Bill, Quits

WASHINGTON — In its final act before adjournment, the 100th Congress sent President Ronald Reagan a compromise bill aimed at curbing the supply of illicit drugs and the public's demand for them.

In other major action, Congress:

- Upped the ante for Wall Street's inside traders, passing legislation to increase fines and prison terms for individual offenders and to penalize investment firms that permit the practice.

- Approved tax-adjustment legislation with a three-year price of \$4.1 billion.

The omnibus drug bill gives more emphasis to efforts to reduce drug consumption through treatment and education programs that had been given low priority in previous drug strategies.

In addition, in a different kind of attack on consumption, the bill would establish a complex and far-reaching
