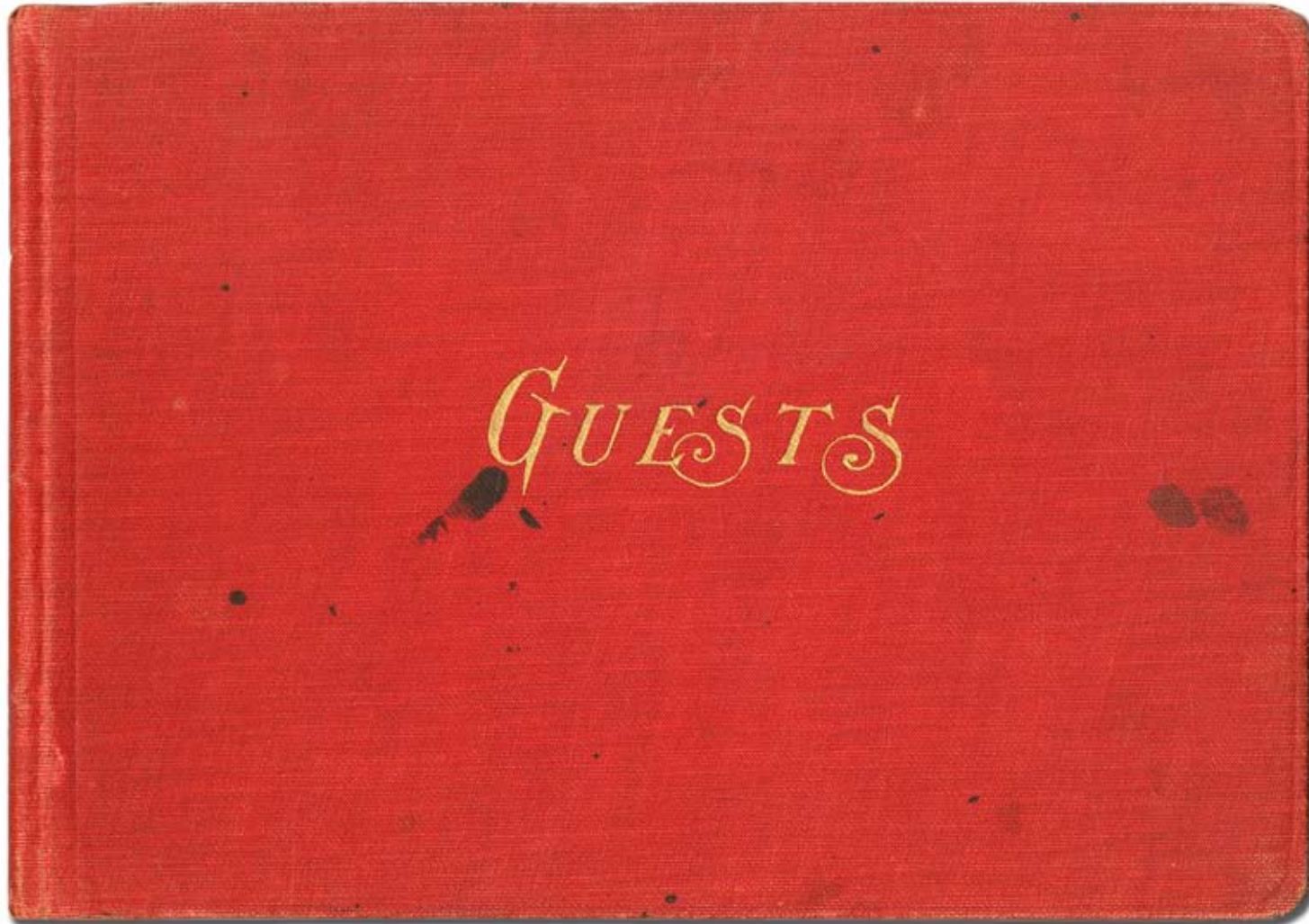

In an entry from December 31, 1930 it reads, "New Years' Eve party, everyone enjoyed it. Welcome New Year - Pinkish Baby! You'll be something different! Maybe?"
