

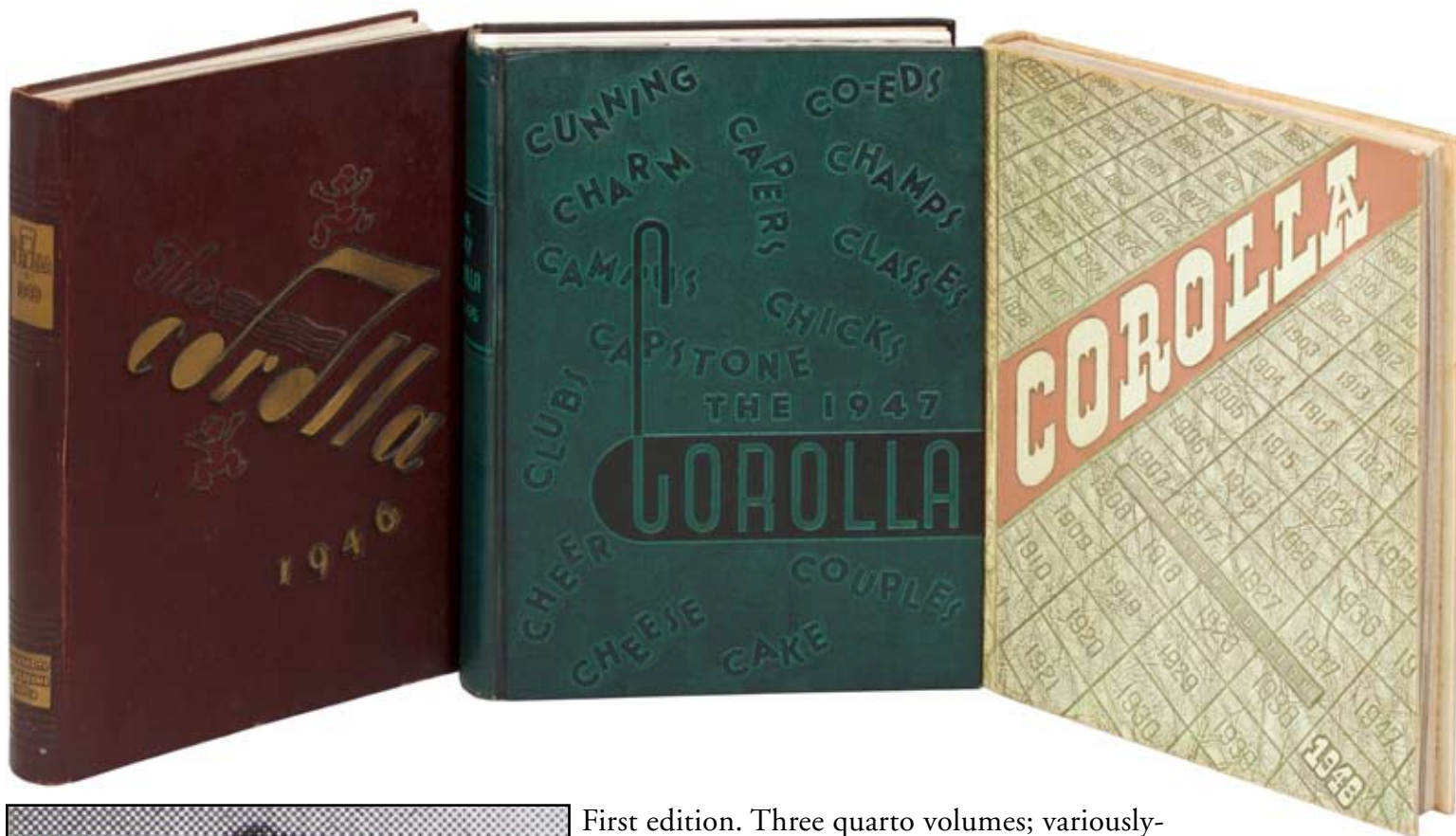

Harper Lee's College Yearbooks

Tuscaloosa: University of Alabama 1946-1948



First edition. Three quarto volumes; variously-colored cloth-covered boards, titled in gilt.

284pp. [44] ads; 362pp., [50] ads; 377pp. [50] ads. All volumes show light wear to board edges; 1946 yearbook shows minor oxidation to gilt, with faint handling to boards edges; 1948 yearbook lightly spine-sunned, with wear at heel and light foxing to text edges; Near Fine, without markings.

A set of yearbooks from the University of Alabama at Tuscaloosa, dating from the period when Harper Lee attended while pursuing a

law degree after leaving Huntingdon College. During her years there, Lee served as the editor of the Rammer Jammer (a humor magazine published on campus), sat on the Board of Publications, a member of the Chi Omega sorority, and was notably active in providing guidance to underclassmen. By 1949 Lee left college and moved to New York to pursue her writing career. More than a dozen photos and mentions of Lee present, providing interesting biographical background to the author's life prior to the publication of her best-selling novel, *To Kill a Mockingbird*. 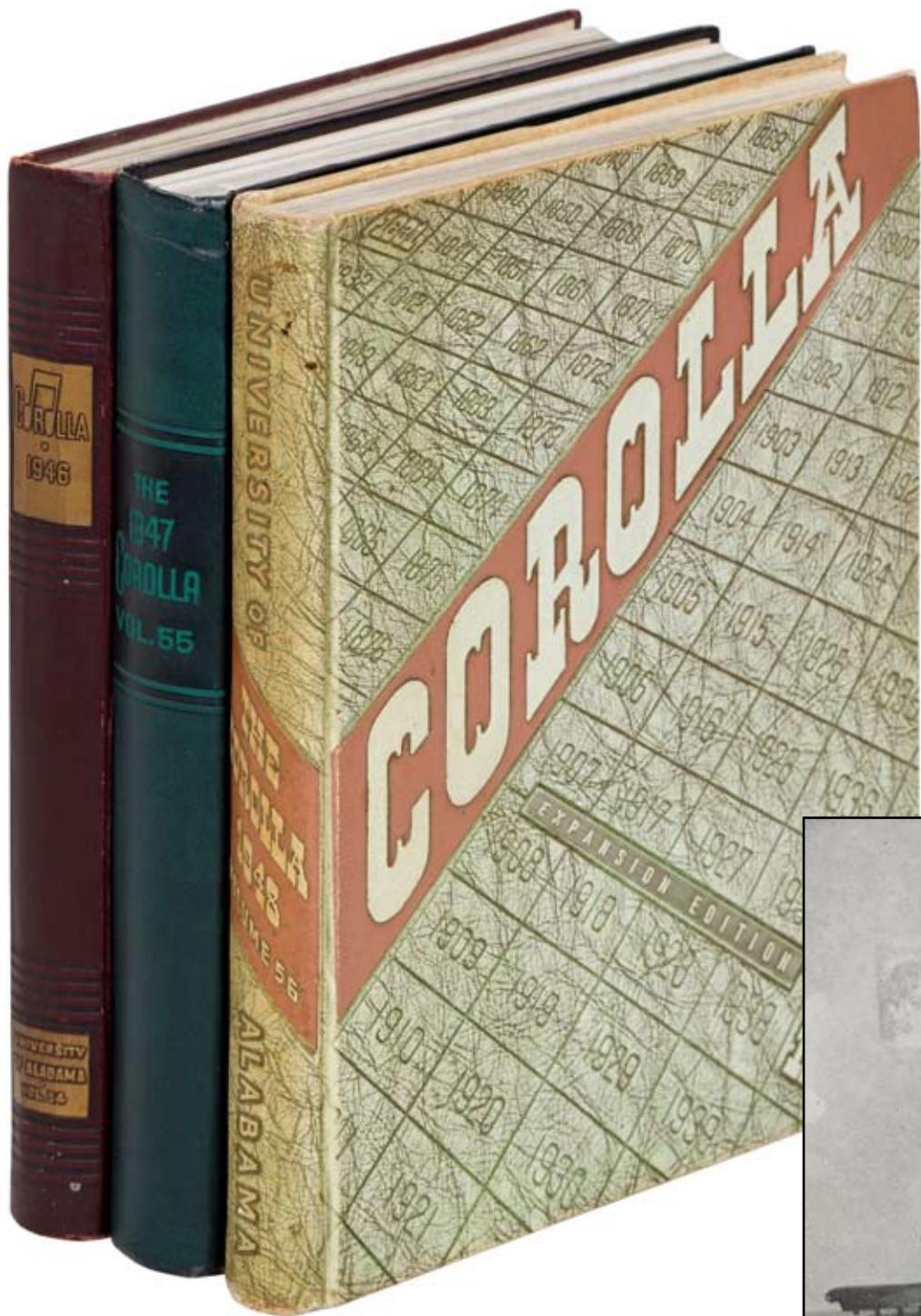
