Stained or soiled in lower right corner, some overall age-toning, tiny nicks in upper left corner, a sound, very good example. Pencil on the back is "Macon, Ga., Williams Colored S'gers, ca. 1940" (we'd guess it was slightly earlier). A small collection of Johnson's papers (¼ lineal feet) are at Emory University and contains some broadsides, but we can't easily determine if this one is among them (a similarly small collection of his papers exists at Michigan State, but does not seem to contain any broadsides).
