A notebook containing production notes from a backstage worker at the 1963 Miss New Jersey Pageant. The book includes handwritten notes, complete with spelling mistakes, lighting instructions, the order of contestants and events, and bios of the judges. It also contains the page long descriptions of all 19 of the contestants describing their measurements, hobbies,

talent, and why they entered the contest. Miss Glassboro State's "talent specialty" was "modeling self made costumes with magical affects" and her hobbies included "sewing, magic, and horseback riding, also knitting." Miss Cape May County wrote that her pet peeve was "false people" and that she was participating in the show because, "it's such a wonderful pageant, further education, and talk to people." Miss Camden County entered to meet people and was excited about "the opportunities presented to the girls," while Miss Atlantic County was in it "for the fun."
