A small album kept by a woman of a camping trip on a lake in the late 1920s. The photos show a group of about 14 girls enjoying their time outside acting silly, hiking, and climbing trees. One group photo shows the women pulling up their skirts to coquettishly reveal their ankles. Many of the photos are silly snapshots of the girls laughing and carrying on away from the societal pressures and roles of the day, able to relax and enjoy each other's company.

The lake and cabin are photographed here and it seems the photographer, presumably one of the women, was trying their hand at honing their skills by taking photos of the women as well as the nature surrounding them.
