Wheel Pump Hotel and Cafe

Five 6" x 8" sepia toned photographs mounted on 8" x 10" card, three are duplicates. Near fine with some edgewear. A collection of mounted photographs of the Wheel Pump Hotel and Cafe in Flourtown, Pennsylvania. The photos appear to have been taken in the 1880s and show the hotel from the front with Scheidt Brewing Company sign hanging on the side of the building. There is also a side view of the building and one with a stage coach and patrons outside of the front door. Built in 1735 the Wheel Pump operated as an inn until recent years. The land was originally purchased in 1715 from William Penn by William Harmer and the town around the hotel was named Wheel Pump, Pennsylvania before undergoing a few name changes and arriving at Flourtown. An interesting collection of photographs of an historic Pennsylvania building.
