A broadside Signed by O'Neill at the conclusion offering lots from the Hardenbergh Patent near the Village of Walton in the county of Delaware, and offering to consider offers from his home in Duaneburg. O'Neill was a shopkeeper, his son and namesake moved to Oregon, where he became one of the early mayors of Portland. Major Johannes Hardenbergh (1670–1745), bought the patent of land in the Catskill Mountains in 1708, it consisted of about 2,000,000 acres.
