

Contains 42 small sepia-toned gelatin silver photographs, most ranging between 21/4" x 3/4" and 21/4" x 21/4". Titled on the cover but otherwise uncaptioned. A lovely little handmade photo album documenting a duck hunting trip (possibly in Nebraska, the only state in which we can find a town so named).



The album show an African-American man and three white men on a sailboat navigating a lake or river, and then in small rowboats, and hunting ducks or other waterfowl. They are depicted sailing, eating, sleeping, brandishing shotguns, hidden with their weapons among the in rushes, and admiring their slain prey. The black man seems to do all the sailing; the white men seem to do the hunting. Small but beautifully composed images. [BTC#402533]
