

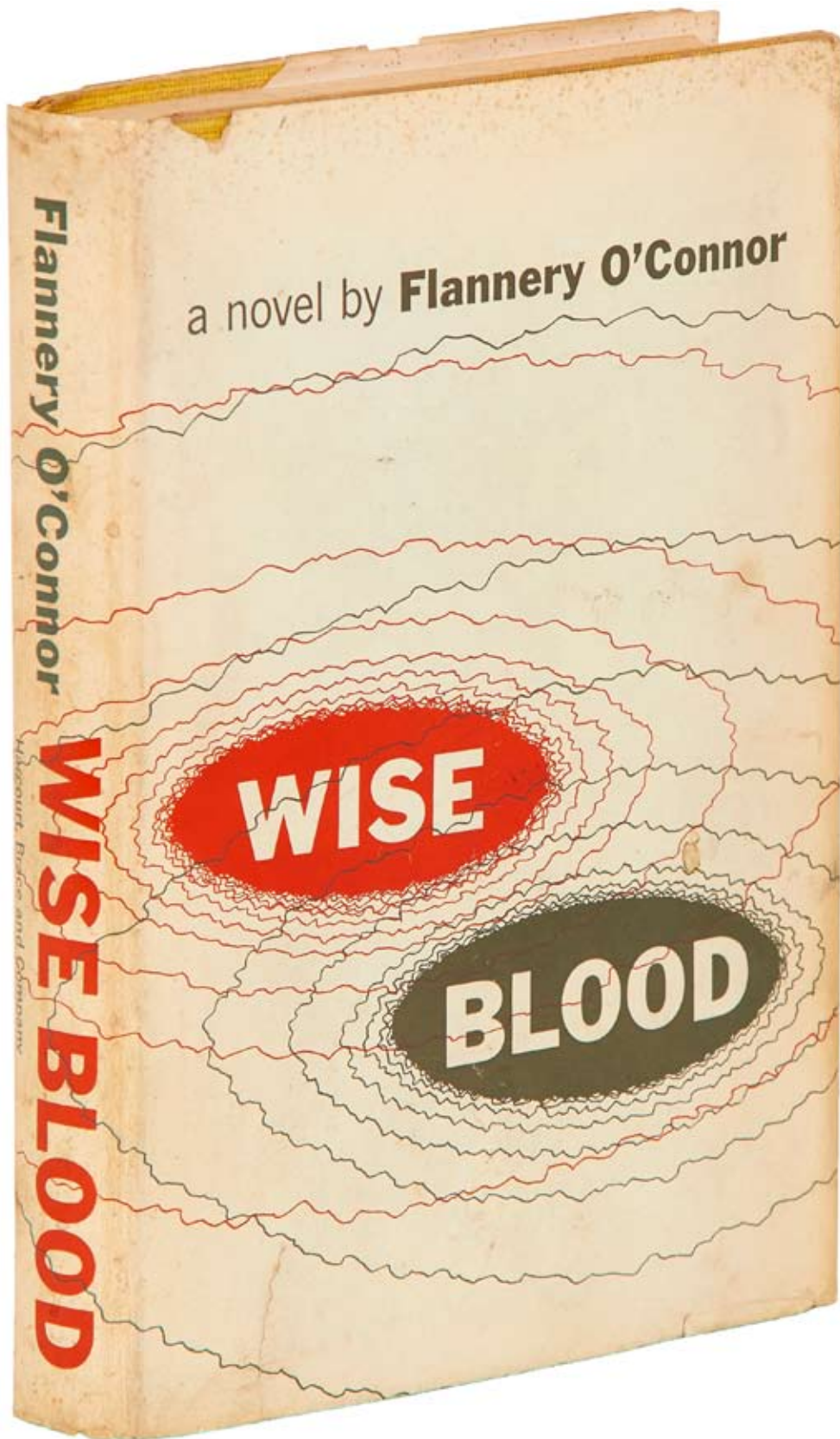

The Georgia author's important first book, with a notable association to the well-regarded Arkansas poet Miller Williams.
