

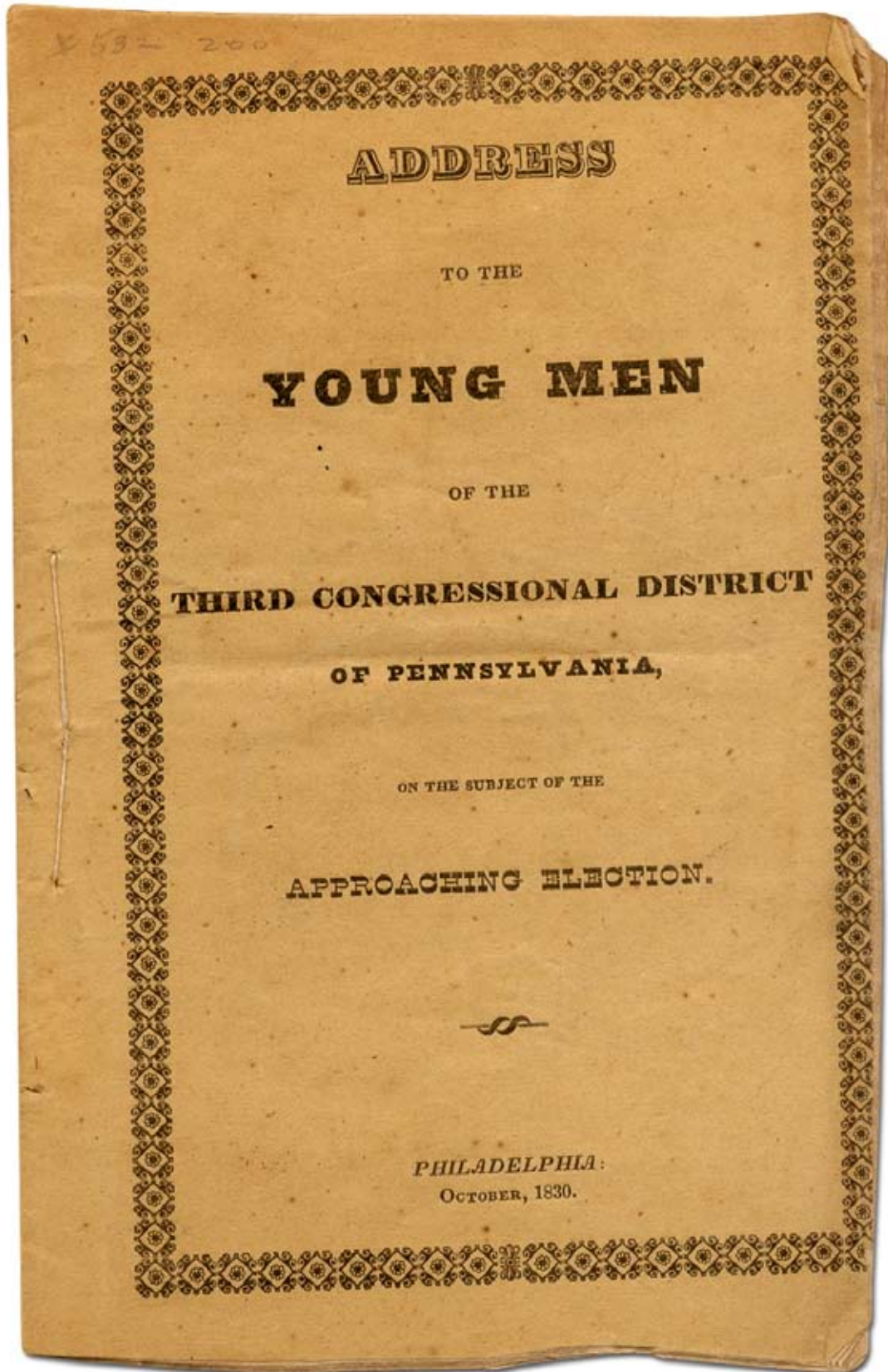

An unattributed address delivered at Franklin House, in support of Colonel J. G. Watmough for Congress.
