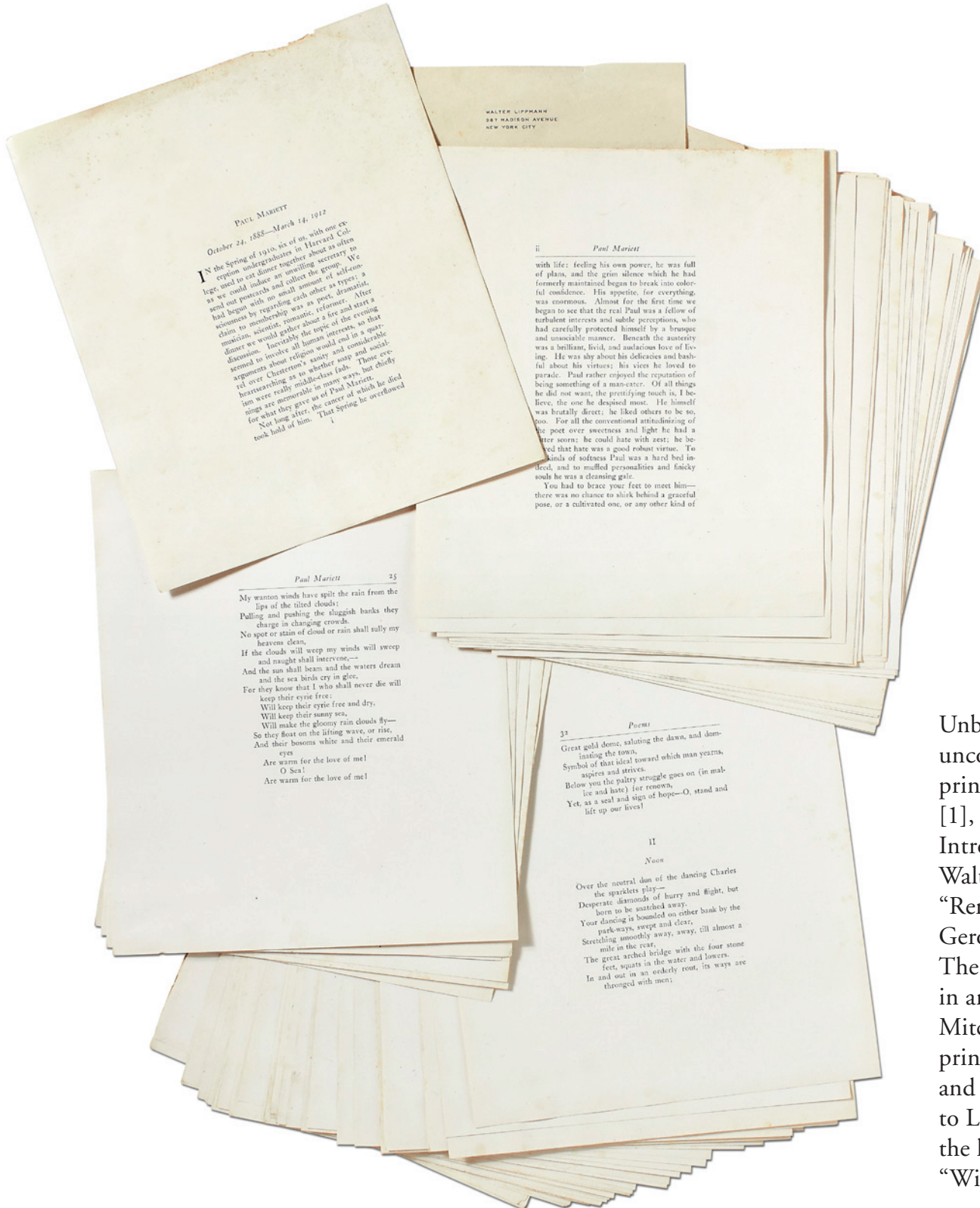

Unbound and uncorrected galley printed recto's only. [1], i-iv, 88pp. Introduction by Walter Lippmann. "Remembrance" by Geroge W. Cronyn. The galley's are housed in an envelope with Mitchell Kennerley's printed return address, and is hand-addressed to Lippman, with the handwritten note "Will Call."

Laid in at the front is a leaf of Lippman's stationary. Envelope worn, the galleys are near fine. Author's posthumously published first and only book. Mariett was Lippman's Harvard classmate and he assembled and helped to pay for publication of Mariett's poems after Marrett's death when both were students at Harvard. An almost certainly unique set of galleys for a very uncommon title by this literary publisher and a particularly poignant association.
