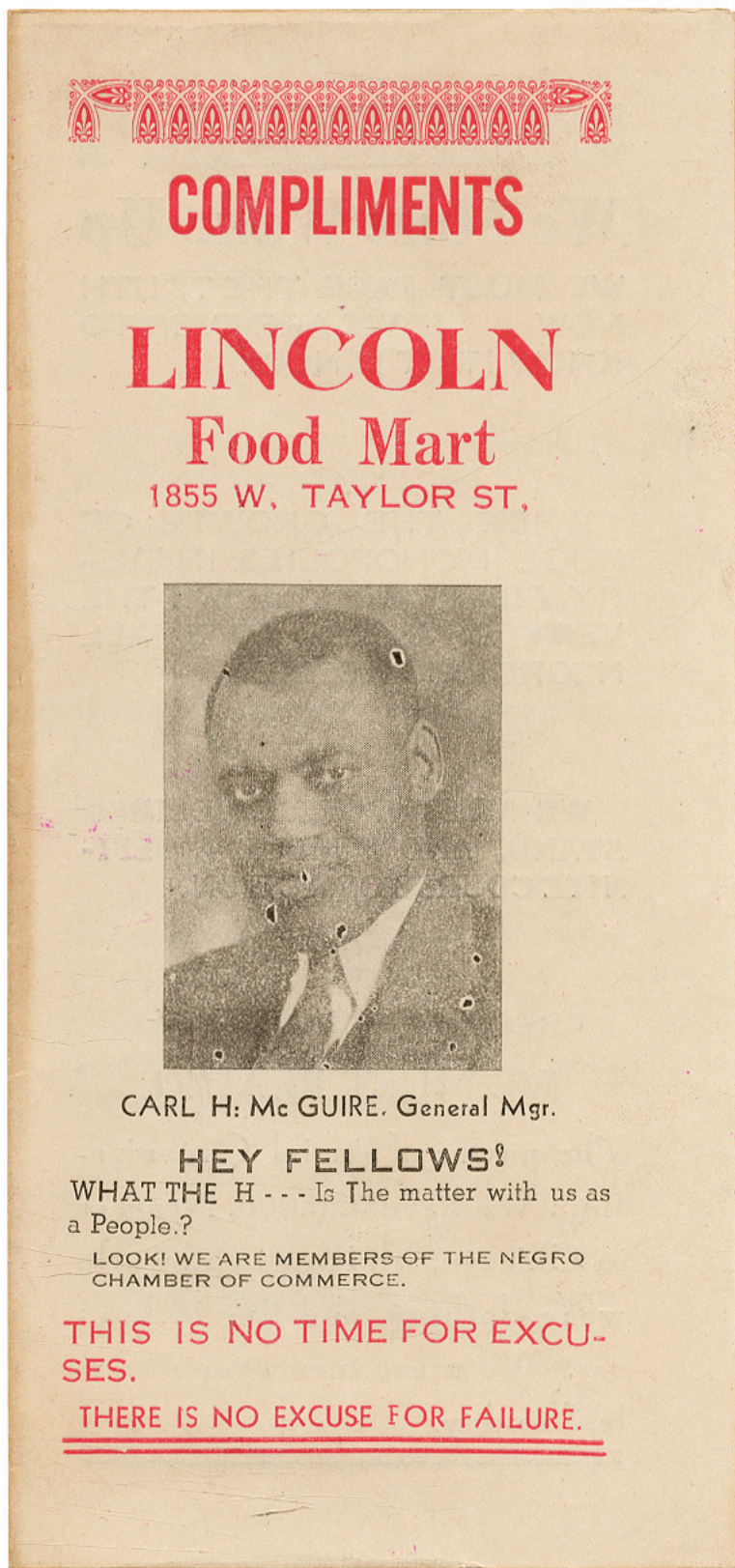

We must have Negro Factories... Stop blaming others for not hiring us when we can do the hiring of our own boys and girls." The Lincoln Food Mart was an African-American owned business.
