A collection of four silk-screened posters for Chicago's 57th Street Art Fair. All are 11" x 17¼" or slightly larger. All are on thick card stock, one with cardboard "stand-ups". Condition and details of individual posters as listed below, but most are very good to near fine. The years are not entirely clear, but we've attributed them, we think, with relative accuracy. A nice, albeit small collection of posters for a long-running Chicago art show, in surprisingly nice condition.

1. 57th Street Art Fair. June 4-5. Silk-screen illustration of a black phoenix against a gold design on white cardstock. Art by Rainey Bennett and George McVicker. Some foxing or light staining in the upper margins, very good. [1966]
2. 57th Street Art Fair. June 8-9. Silk-screen illustration of a black tree on a white background. Art by Elizabeth Oppenheim and George McVicker. Some modest foxing on the image, and additional foxing on the verso, very slight foxing, else fine. [1968]
3. Chicago's 57th St. Art Fair. 25th Anniversary. Silk-screen designed of overlapping circles in red and black on silver background. About fine. Design by Leach. [1972]
4. 57th Street Art Fair. June 5 & 6. Silk-screen psychedelic design in orange, purple, and mustard gold. Design by Carafoli. Some modest soiling and smudging, very good. With cardboard stand-up. [1973].
