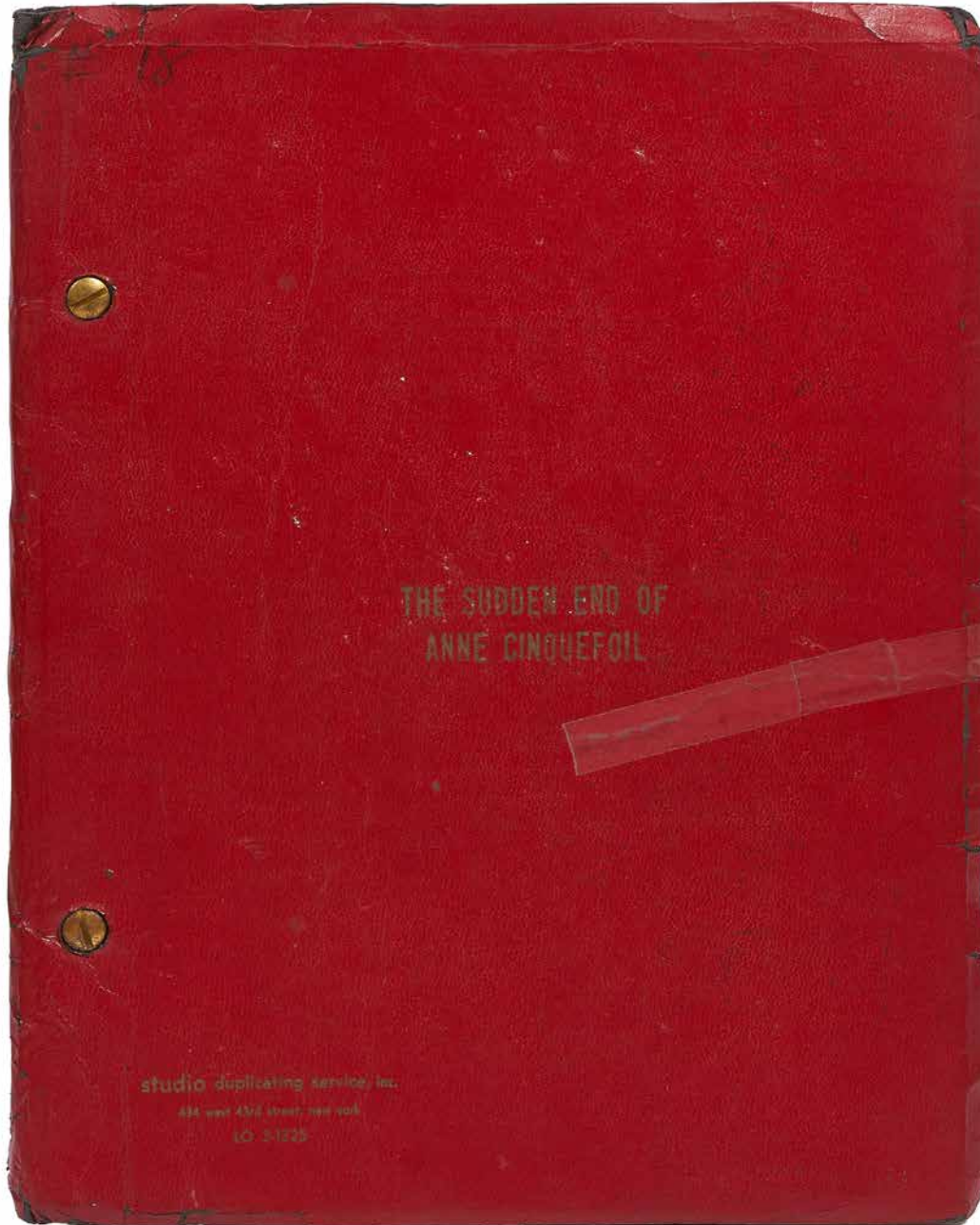

A short-lived production by the playwright brother of actress Katharine Hepburn that debuted at the East End Theatre in New York on January 10, 1961. The play starred Priscilla Morrill as the title character, an 18th Century South Carolina woman who proudly has five children with different men and spent time as a pirate queen.
