



[Loose Photographs]: American Nurses Holding Medicine

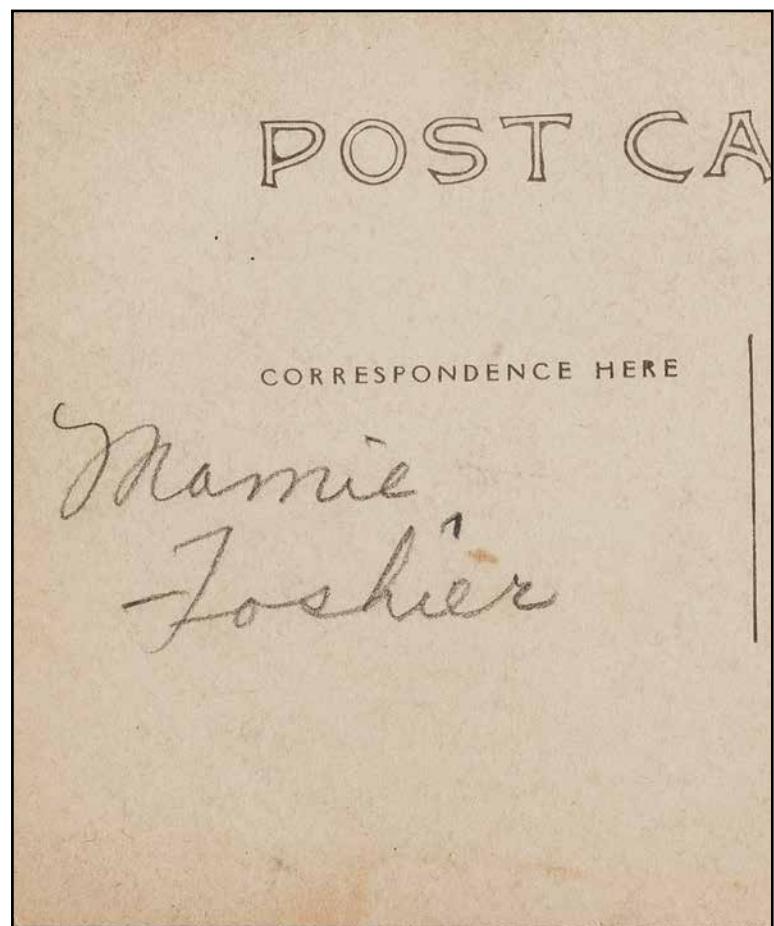

A collection of six black and white or sepia toned albumen photographs of nurse taken between the late 1800s and early 1900s. All the photographs are very good with some rubbing and slight creasing. The photos all show turn-of-the-century nurses holding medicine and either posed for a professional portrait or, in some cases, posed in their homes or the homes of their patients.

Three of the photos are cabinet cards and include photography studio stamps and place names including McFarlin in Elmira, New York, Truscott Brothers in Falmouth, Massachusetts, and Central Music Hall Studios in Chicago, Illinois. One of the photographs, a pictorial postcard, has the name of Mamie Foshier written on the verso.
