A guidebook to hallucinogenic substances, describing 85 plants, mushrooms, and synthetic substances, "a first attempt to bring practical knowledge to the uninformed public of where and how to obtain psychedelics with little or no expense ..."

Dedicated by the author to Richard Alpert, Richard Forrest, and Bernard Copley. The publisher, The Society for the Advancement of Self-Knowledge and Evolution seems to have left no other trace. The seal on the last page suggests "magical" origins. According to the author "My personal opinion is that psychedelic substances should be made available for all who seek to explore the reaches of their own mind and soul, and that laws restricting such activity are instituted primarily out of the fear of our 'unknown' inner selves. ...NO ONE can fail to benefit in some manner from the expansion of perception, sensation, and consciousness which the psychedelics bring about." A rare and early exploration of psychedelic drugs. Not in *OCLC*, and apparently unrecorded. [BTC#421946]
