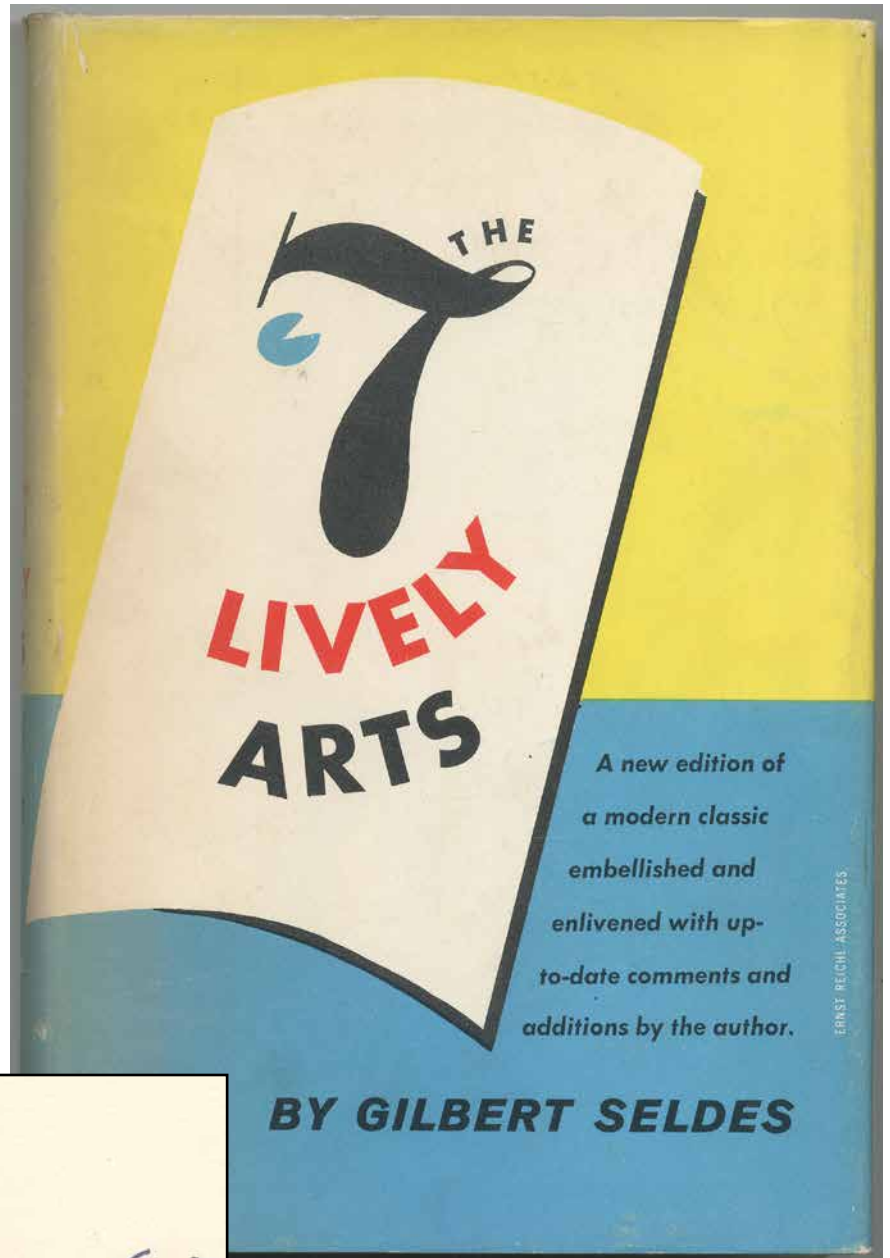

Originally published in 1924, this edition has been completely revised and updated by the author. The printed dedication reads: "To My Father and now to my daughter and to her daughter. In Memoriam: A. H. S." After "her daughter" Seldes has written "Kat-Kat" (his granddaughter, Katharine Claman) and at the end of the printed dedication he has written "from Grampa."
