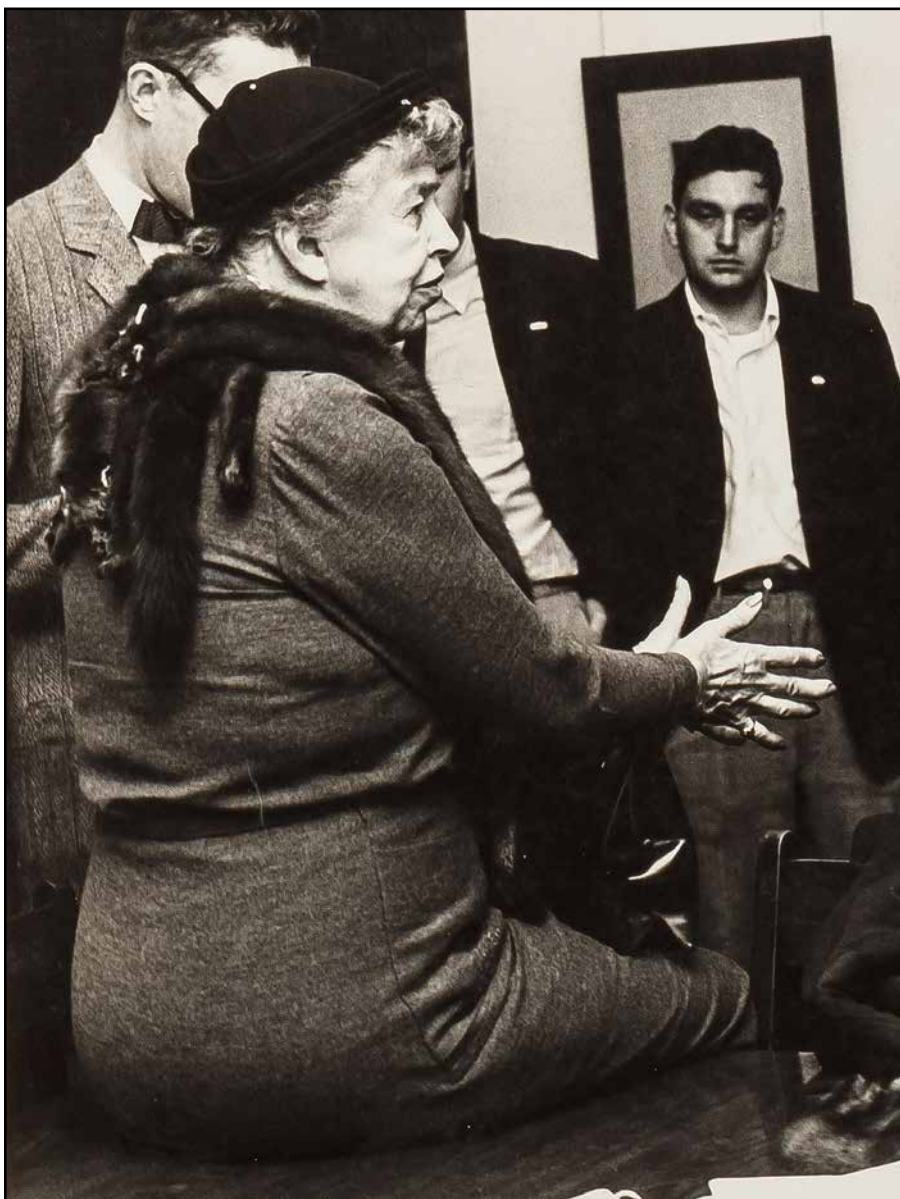


Eleanor Roosevelt

The photo depicts Mrs. Roosevelt informally sitting on a table and speaking to a female reporter with other male reporters around them during a press conference after a speech she gave at the college. This image was used in the October 27th, 1952 edition of the paper in an article about Roosevelt who was campaigning at Yale on behalf of Adlai Stevenson. According to the article, 600 students attended the event and gave the former First Lady three standing ovations as she declared that Stevenson was better suited for the presidency than Eisenhower.
