Incomplete run of 30 issues (with several duplicates) of periodical *The Word Carrier*, an English language periodical published for the Eastern Dakota Indians at the Sioux Santee Agency in Nebraska. The folded newspapers each consist of four printed pages. A couple of issues have photographs on the front page and one issue has a map. All papers are in very good or better condition; the 1937 issue has a couple of closed splits to the paper at the folds.
