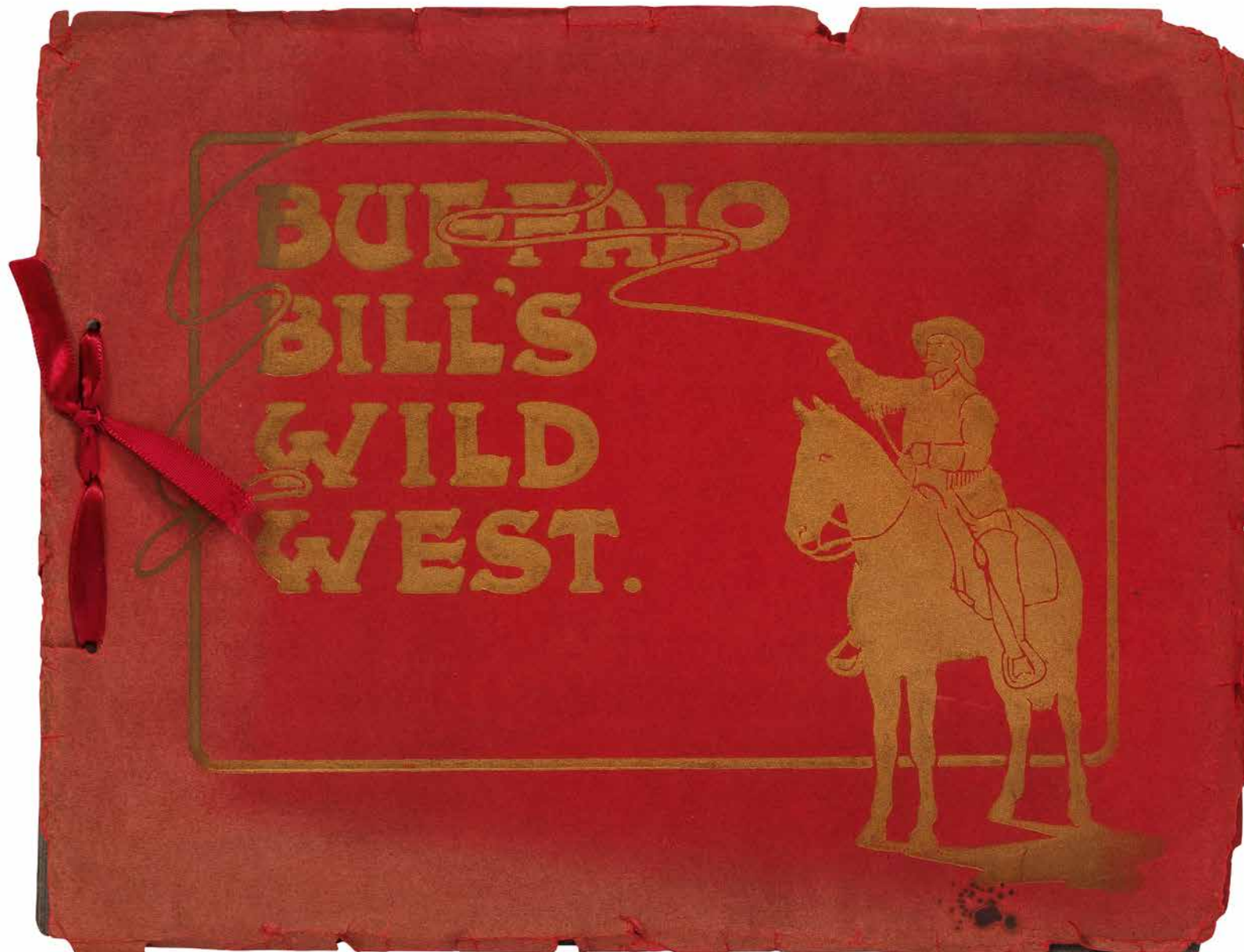

A photographic souvenir program for Buffalo Bill's Wild West show with mounted images by English photographer, Carl Vandyk. Each image includes "C. Vanyk London S.W." written in the negative. Vandyk was a prosperous photographer in London who was a favorite of the Royal family, often taking photographs of Queen Victoria and her family. This souvenir presumably accompanied the Buffalo Bill's Wild West show on its 1902-1906 European Tour. The photos feature members of the stage show horseback riding, shooting, and capturing Native Americans.
