

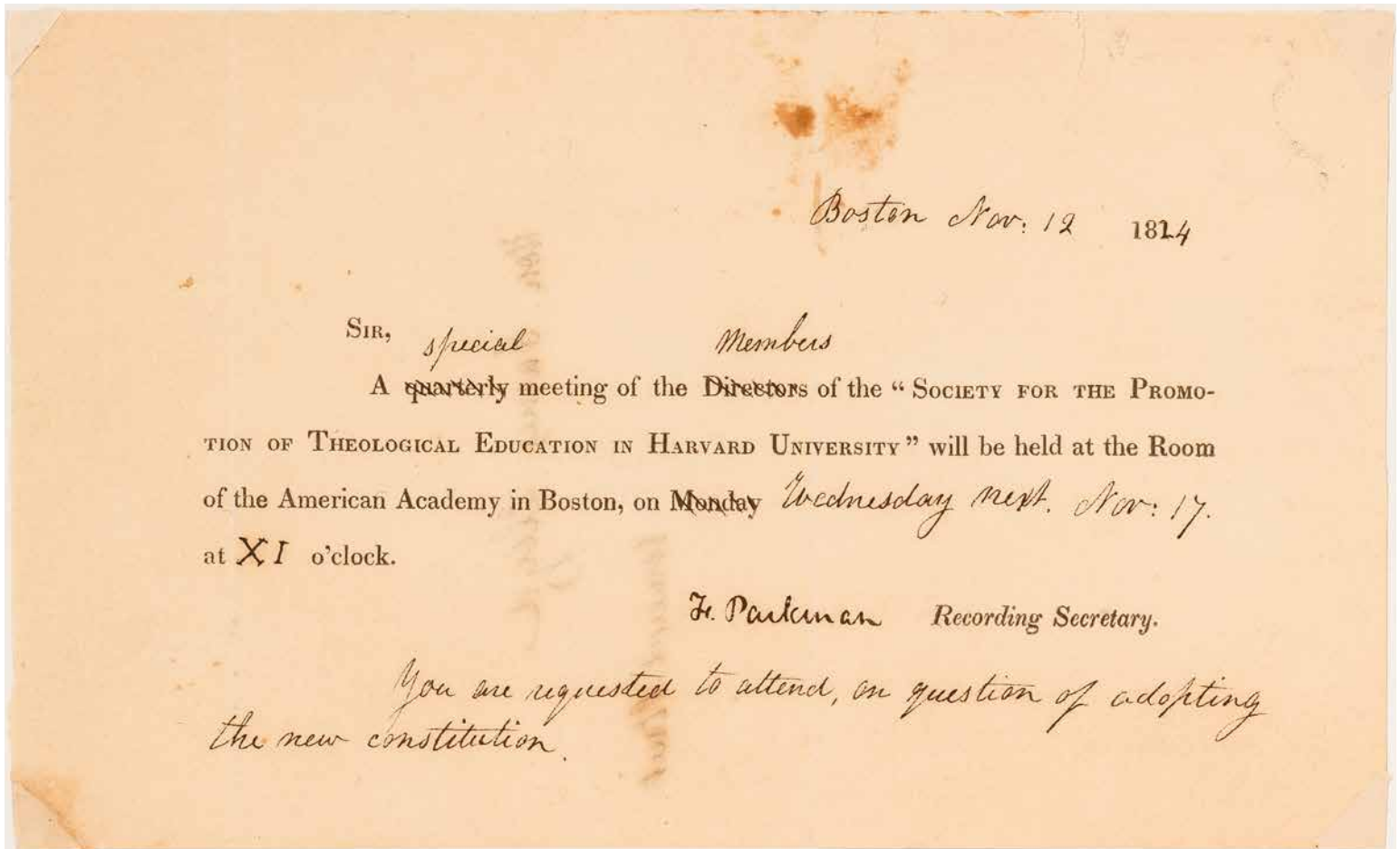
Theological Promotion at Harvard

[Partially Printed Circular Letter]: Rev. Francis Parkman invites Senator James Lloyd to a meeting of the Society for the Promotion of Theological Education in Harvard University, 1824

Approximately 8" x 5". Two old folds from mailing, small paper remnants in the corners from old mounts, and a couple of slight smudges, else near fine. Dated November 12, 1824 and addressed to Harvard graduate and Senator James Lloyd on the verso. Signed and addressed by Parkman ("Fr. Parkman"), as Recording Secretary of the Society for the Promotion of Theological Education in Harvard University announcing a special meeting at the American Academy in Boston, with a note written in an unknown hand requesting Lloyd to attend on the question of adopting a new constitution. Lloyd was the U.S. Senator for Massachusetts in 1808-1813 and again in 1823-1826. Rev. Francis Parkman, Sr. was the minister of the Unitarian New North Church in Boston from 1813 to 1849, (and the father of the noted historian Francis Parkman, Jr., author of *The Oregon Trail* and *Sketches of Prairie and Rocky-Mountain Life*.)
