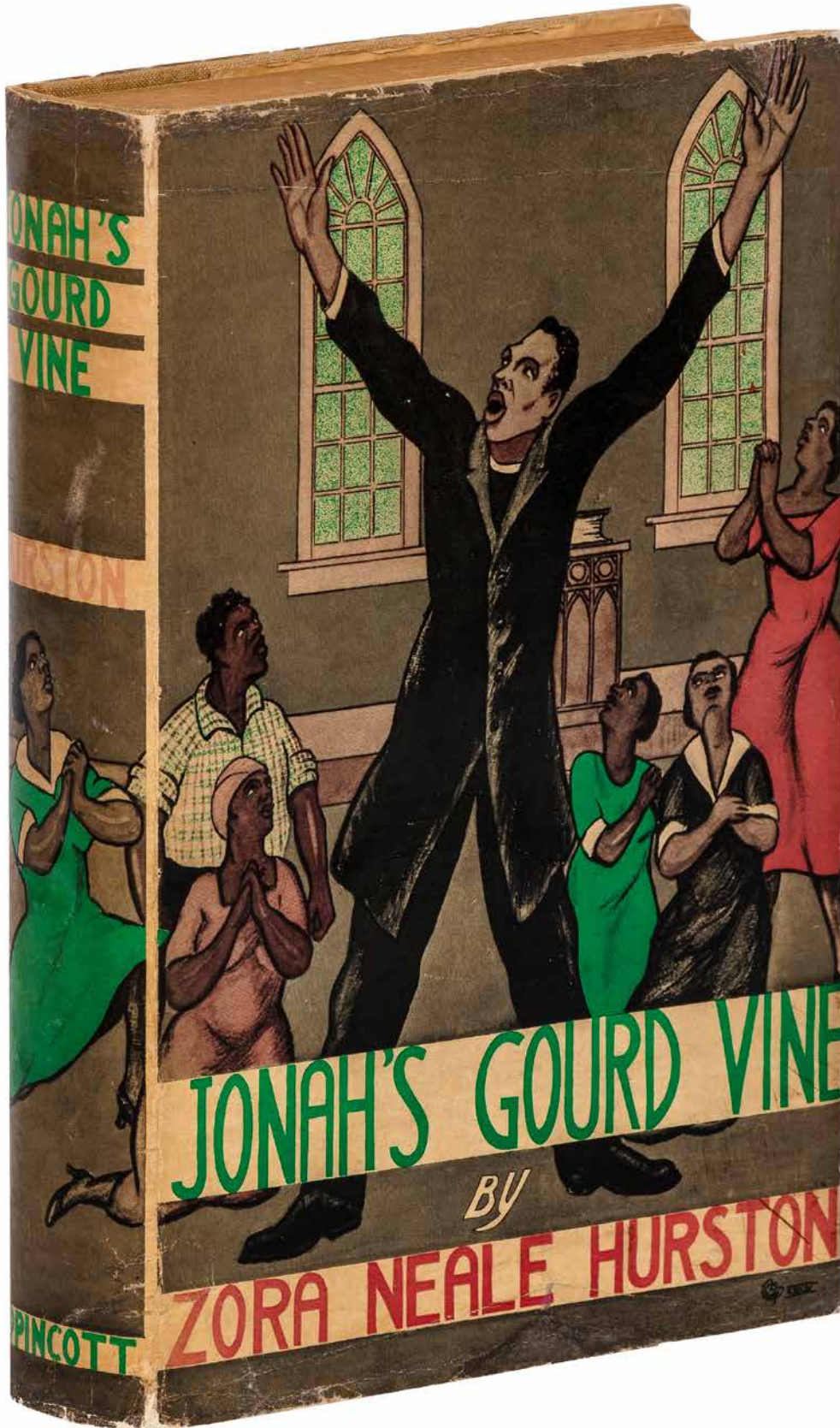


Zora Neale Hurston
