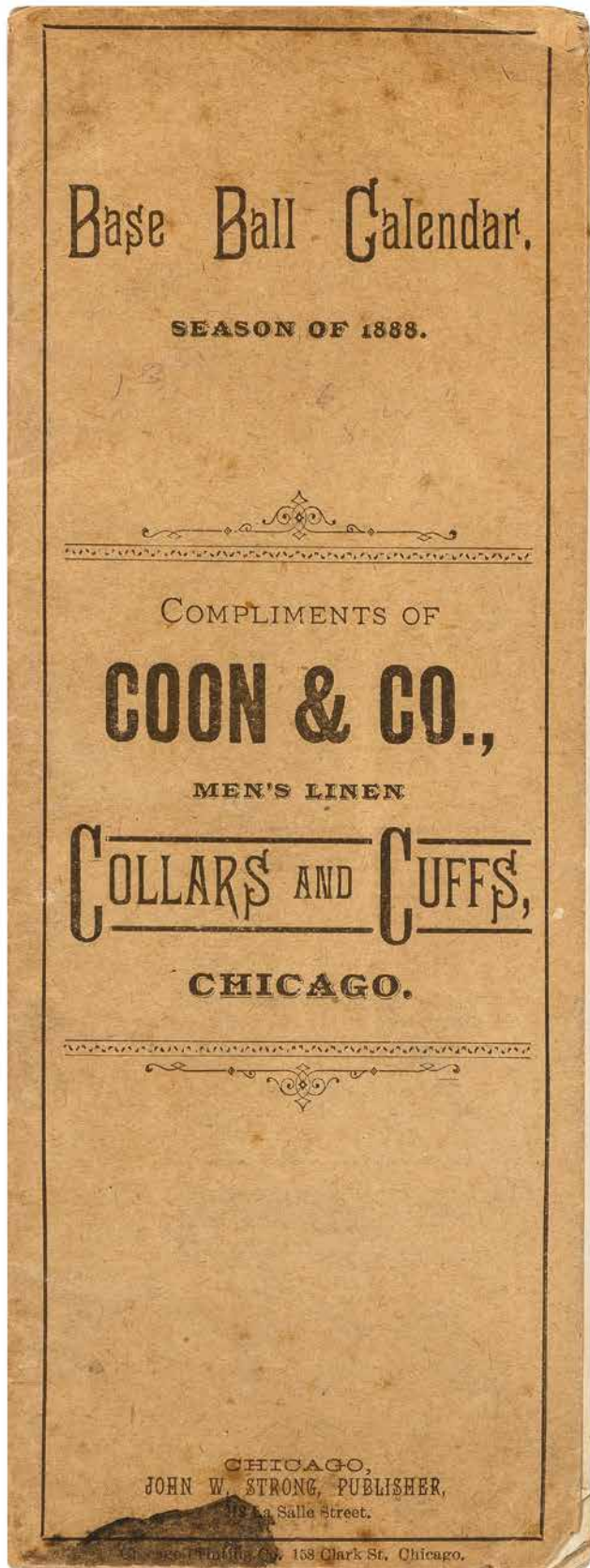

Detailed baseball schedule for the pro game with rules, team standings, stats for professional ball (Cap Anson hit .421, only good enough for second, with Dan Brouthers and King Kelly also in the top ten), ranks of pro players at each position (Tim Keefe was the No. 1 pitcher; John Montgomery Ward was the highest paid at \$5000 per annum), history of the game, etc., with many ads for Chicago businesses, including a railroad map and "Cash Paid for Old Books" by Barker. before touching a Fielder, and in such case no base shall be run, unless forced by the Batter becoming a Base Runner, and no run be scored.

If, when running a base or forced to return to a base, he fail to touch the intervening base or bases, he may be put out at the base he fails to touch, or by being touched by the ball in the hand of a Fielder, in the same manner as in running to First Base.

If, when the Umpire calls "Play," after any suspension of a game, he fails to return to and touch the base he occupied when "Time" was called, before touching the next base.

Whenever a Block occurs, the Umpire shall declare it, and Base Runners may run the bases without being put out, until after the ball has been returned to and held by the Pitcher standing in his position.

If a person not engaged in the game should retain possession of the ball, or throw or kick it beyond the reach of the Fielders, the Umpire should call "Time," and require each Base Runner to stop at the last base touched by him, until the ball be returned to the Pitcher, standing in his position
