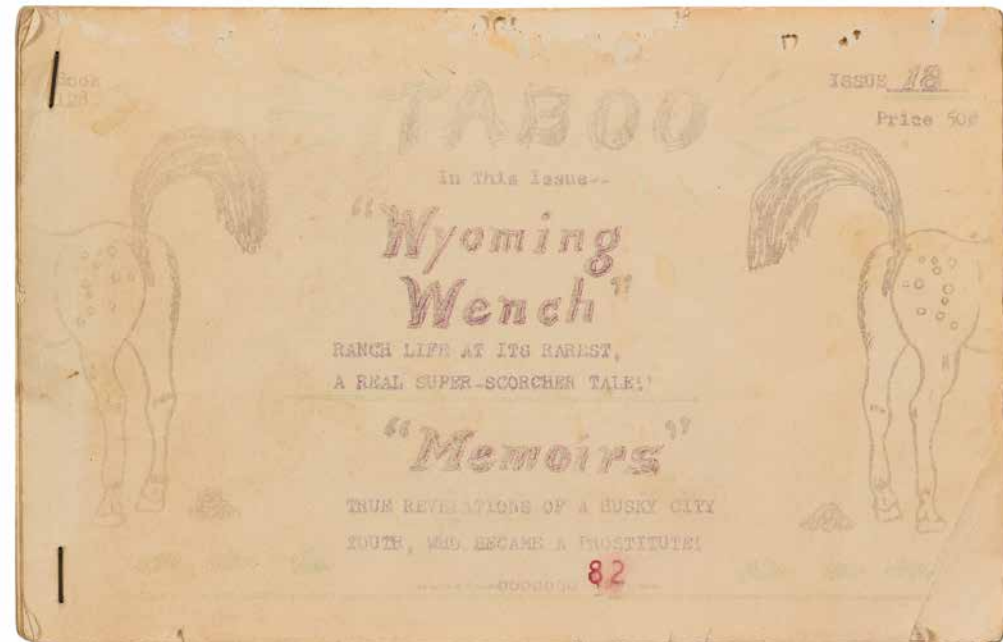
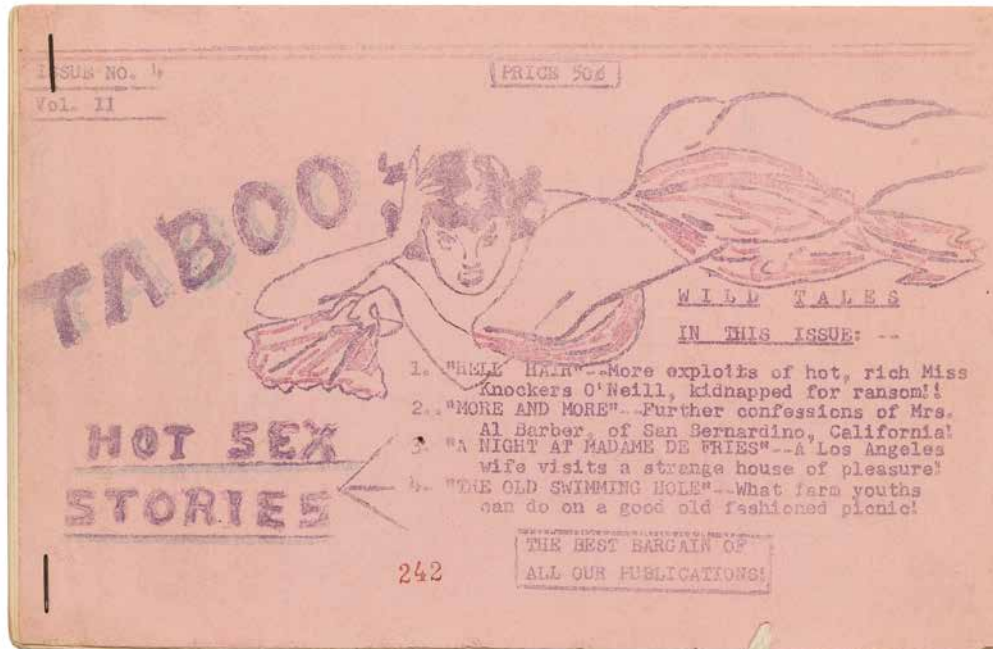


## Two issues of *Taboo* - #4 and #18

Two issues. Each measuring 5½" x 8½". Mimeographs sheets with stapled wrappers with illustrated covers and numbered stamps ("242" and "82"), as issued. Very good with wear along the spines, along with scattered wear at the edges of both including nicks, tears and bumping. Two issues of pornographic stories from the notorious publisher, The 7 Zephyrs Press, filled with tales of the awakening of virginal girls, playful farmhands, and young, naive street hustlers. While we have encountered copies of several different publications from 7 Zephyrs over the years, including this title, we have never seen one in this oblong format or with such an early publication date (if it can be trusted). While touted as "The Best Bargain of All Our Publications!", these two half-sized issues are priced at 50 cents each, which was 25 cents more than the typical 8½" x 11" issue. We have never seen another copy in this format. Rare. OCLC locates no copies. [BTC#424872]
