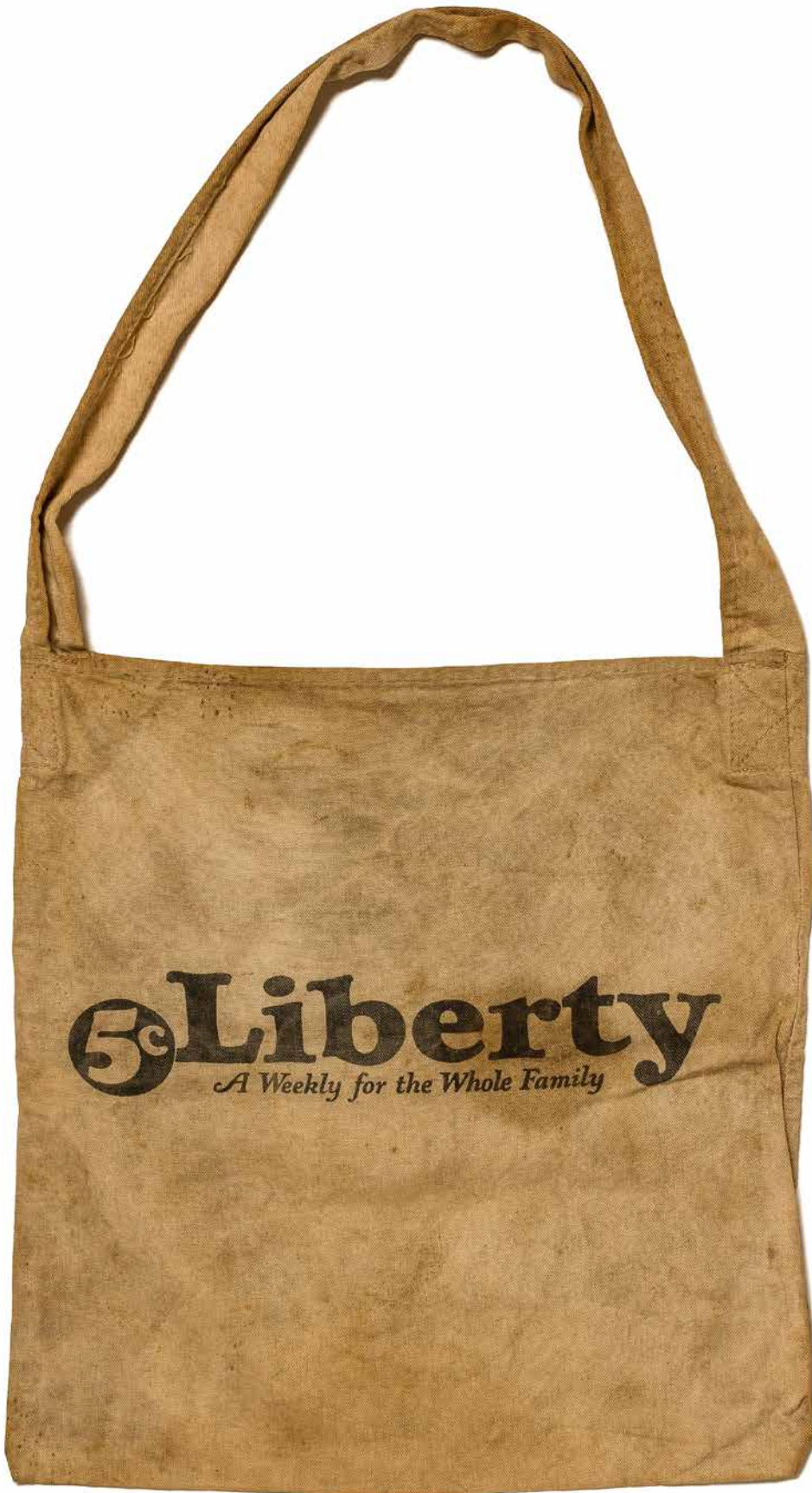


(Carrier bag): *Liberty: A Weekly for the Whole Family. 5c*

Canvas shoulder bag with “*Liberty: A Weekly for the Whole Family. 5c*” stamped on each side. Some age-toning and soiling, but with no other significant wear and essentially intact and very good. Considered the second most popular generally interest magazine of its time, after the *Saturday Evening Post*, the magazine was founded in 1924, changed ownership and editorship on a few occasions and stopped publication in 1950. This sort of bag would have been used by a newsboy to vend the magazine on the streets. Our attribution of date is an estimate - for most of the 1930s the magazine cost 5c; for most of the 1940s 10c.
