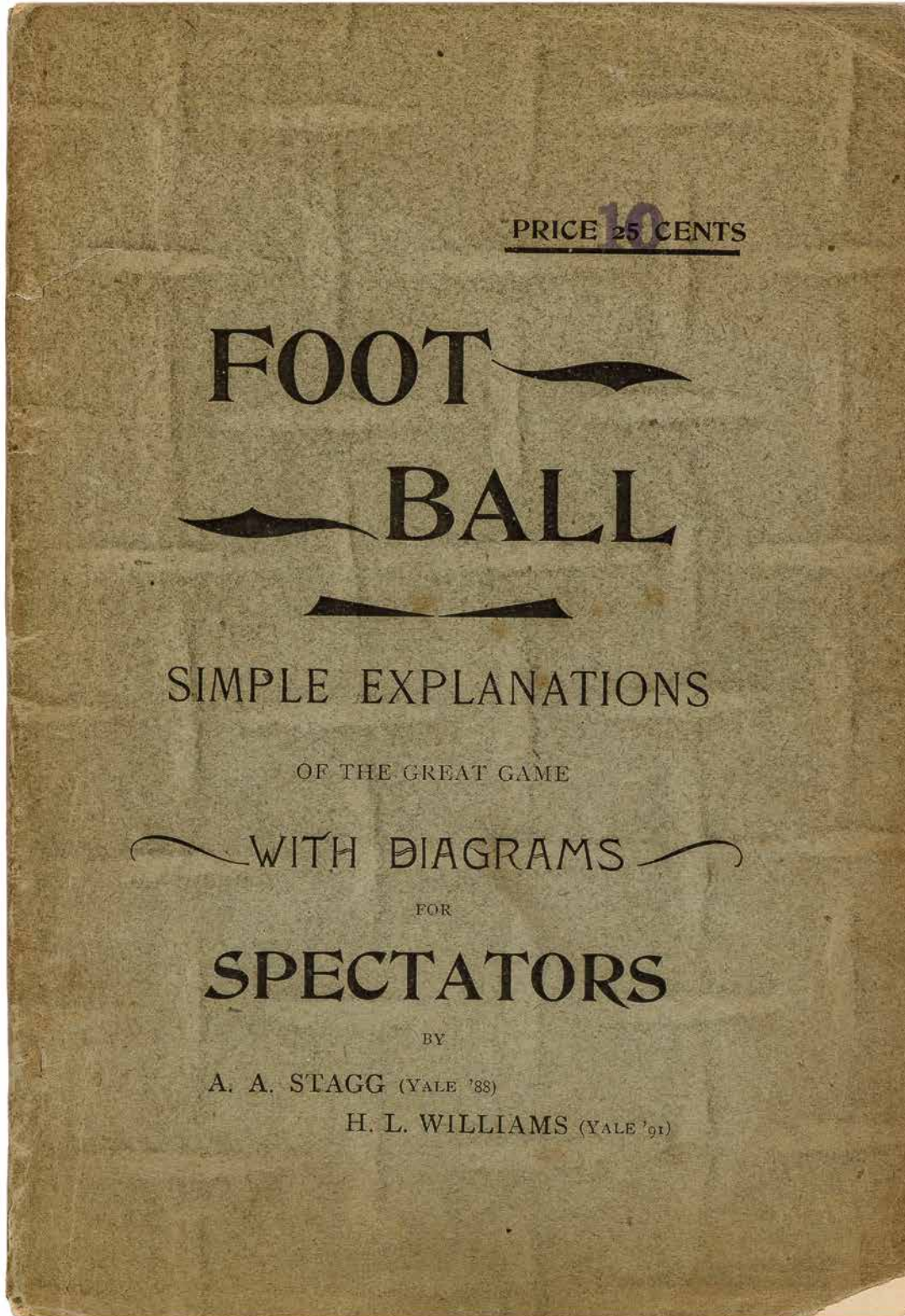

Small chip at the spine and front wrap, very good or better. Excerpted in the same year from the author's *A Scientific and Practical Treatise on American Football for Schools and Colleges*. Selection of pages of both text and diagrams from that book, which itself was one of the earliest and most important books on the game of American Football, issued the same year as the book. Rare. OCLC locates no copies of the promotional booklet. *Grobani* 26-1, lists this title as the first title in his section of Dictionaries and Guides, and describes it as being issued in cloth; presumably the wrapped edition would be even less likely to survive.

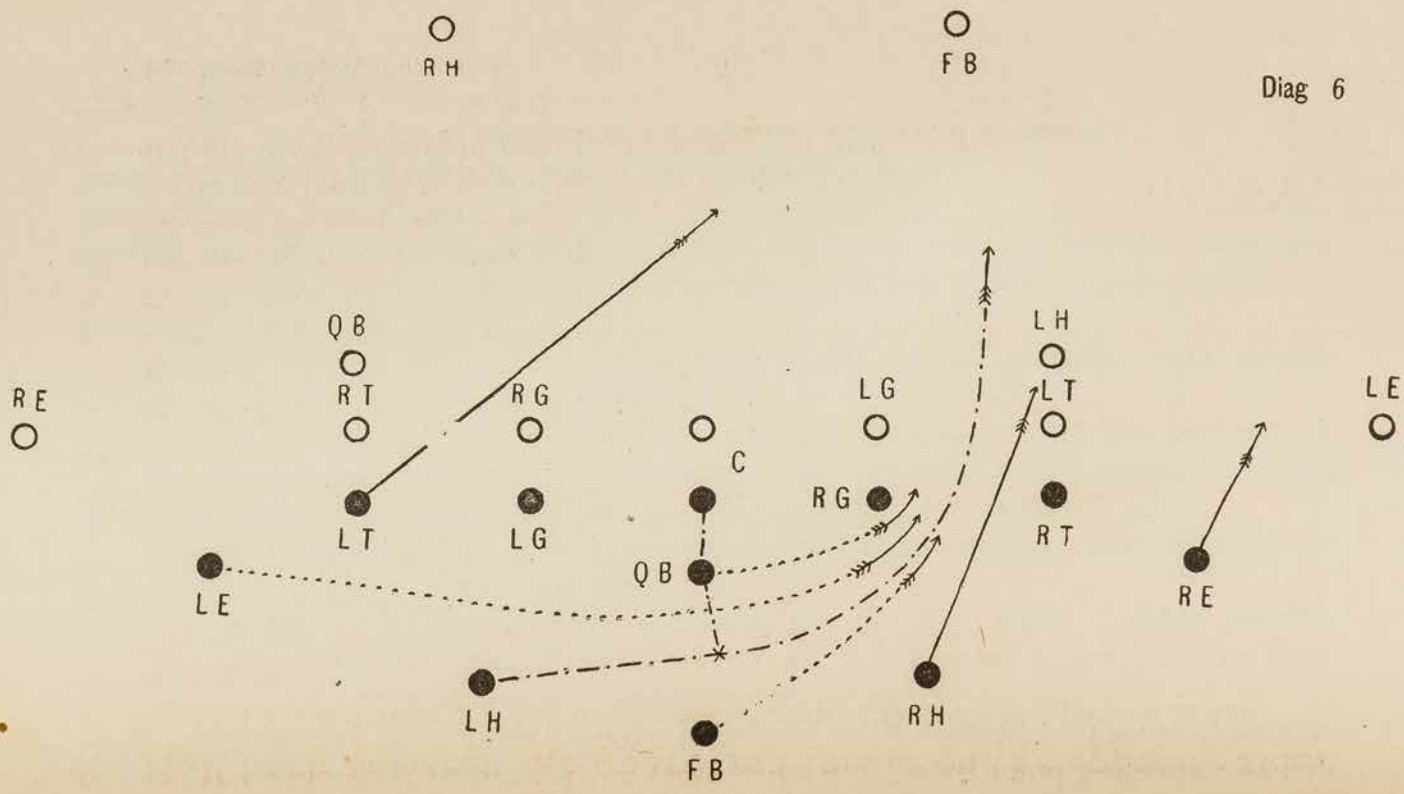
