Illustrated broadside. Approximately 10" x 13". A little age-toning, else fine. The central image depicts an older bearded artist displaying finer paintings, while looking askance at a young artist in a beanie hat proudly displaying his paintings of voluptuous nude women. In 1931 Jackson Pollack and Willem DeKooning in desperate financial straits, set up and sold paintings informally in Washington Square Park. Over the next few years, the Exhibition was organized and has continued to this day for over over 80 years, now held twice a year. This poster from the early days of the event and on thin card stock is unlikely to have survived in great numbers. Unrecorded in *OCLC*. [BTC#425970]
