The first 44 pages are used for the dissertation, someone has turned the book over and the last dozen or so pages were used in 1848 for accounts and as a commonplace book. The manuscript of the dissertation by Abraham Ruth (1820-1890), from Bernville, Berks County, a town about equidistant between Harrisburg and Allentown, written when the author was about 21.
