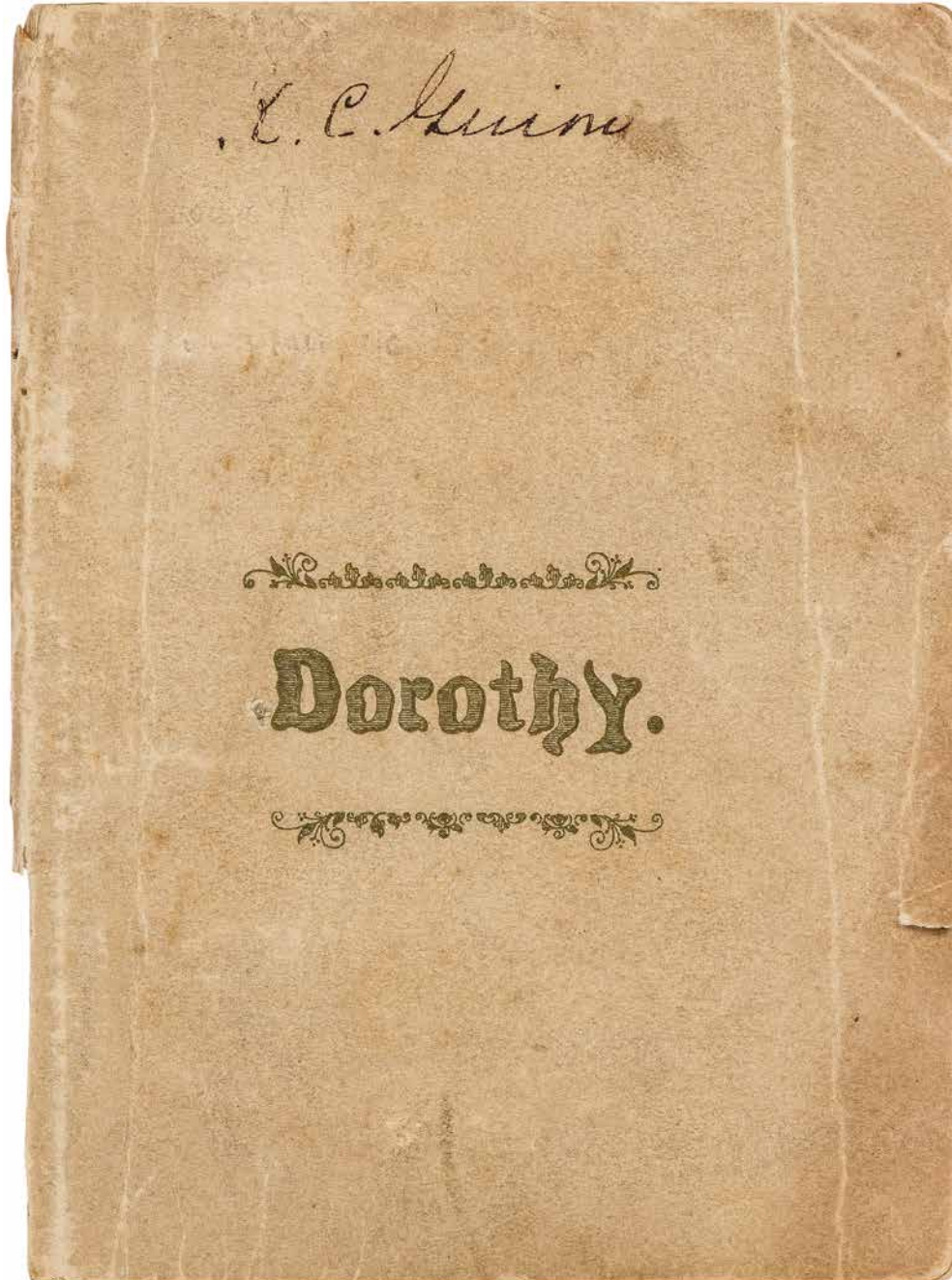

Gift inscription on the first leaf, contemporary name on the front wrap, small tears and wear, and a modest vertical crease on the front wrap, a couple of easily erasable pencil squiggles, a good or better copy. A longer story, mostly written in black dialect. Caldwell was the daughter of a North Carolina Congressman, and the widow of a Confederate Colonel who was killed at Snicker's Gap, Virginia.
