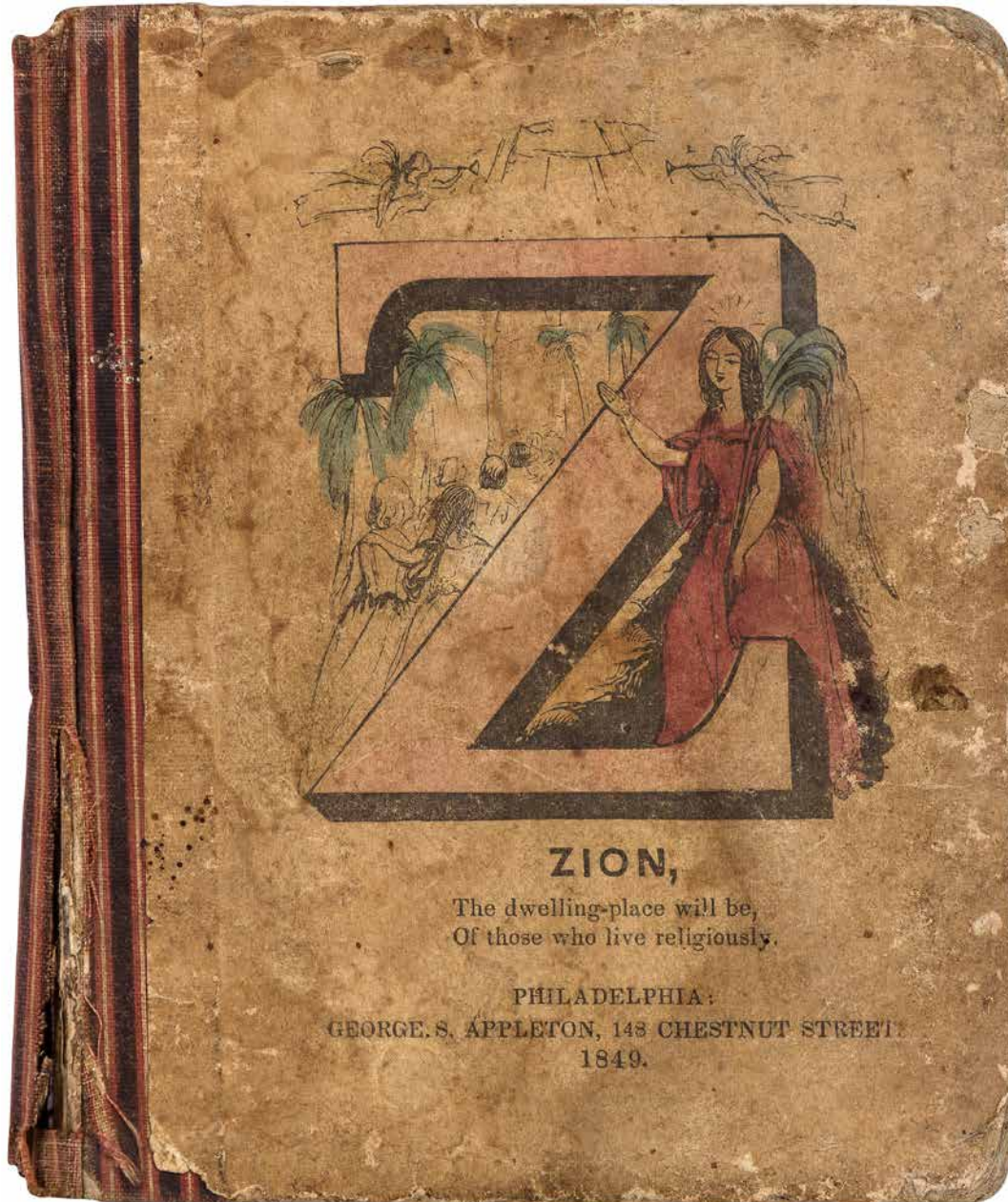

First edition. 24mo. One folded leaf [26]pp. in card covers. Illustrated with printed letters that have been handcolored at an early date. This copy with an early calico cloth spine, whether it was issued bound or was intended to be folded out is unclear from the artifactual evidence (with doing further damage, and we subscribe to the bookseller's equivalent of the Hypocratic Oath). Tears along the spine, wear on the boards, and stains and smudges on the leaves, overall sound and about good. The title deduced from where it appears on the rear board in a list of titles by this publisher and author. Our *OCLC* searches reveal a single copy (American Antiquarian Society).
