A collection of 9 mounted architectural photographs measuring 7½" x 9½" mounted on 11" x 14" blue boards with typed caption labels on the verso. Very good with some of the photographs lifting from the boards and edgewear.

A small archive of mounted photographs of two buildings in Philadelphia in 1927. The buildings are the Crozer Building and the North American Building both Philadelphia architectural landmarks both designed in the 1800s. These images were taken by the construction firm of F.V. Warren and the design and alterations were done by Pennsylvania architect, Le Roy B. Rothschild. The photos include labels on the verso with typed captions that describe the image as being a before or after shot of the projects. Many of the images show street scenes from 1920s Philadelphia as well as a few interiors of the buildings. The mounted images are numbered 3 to 11, missing 1 and 2.
