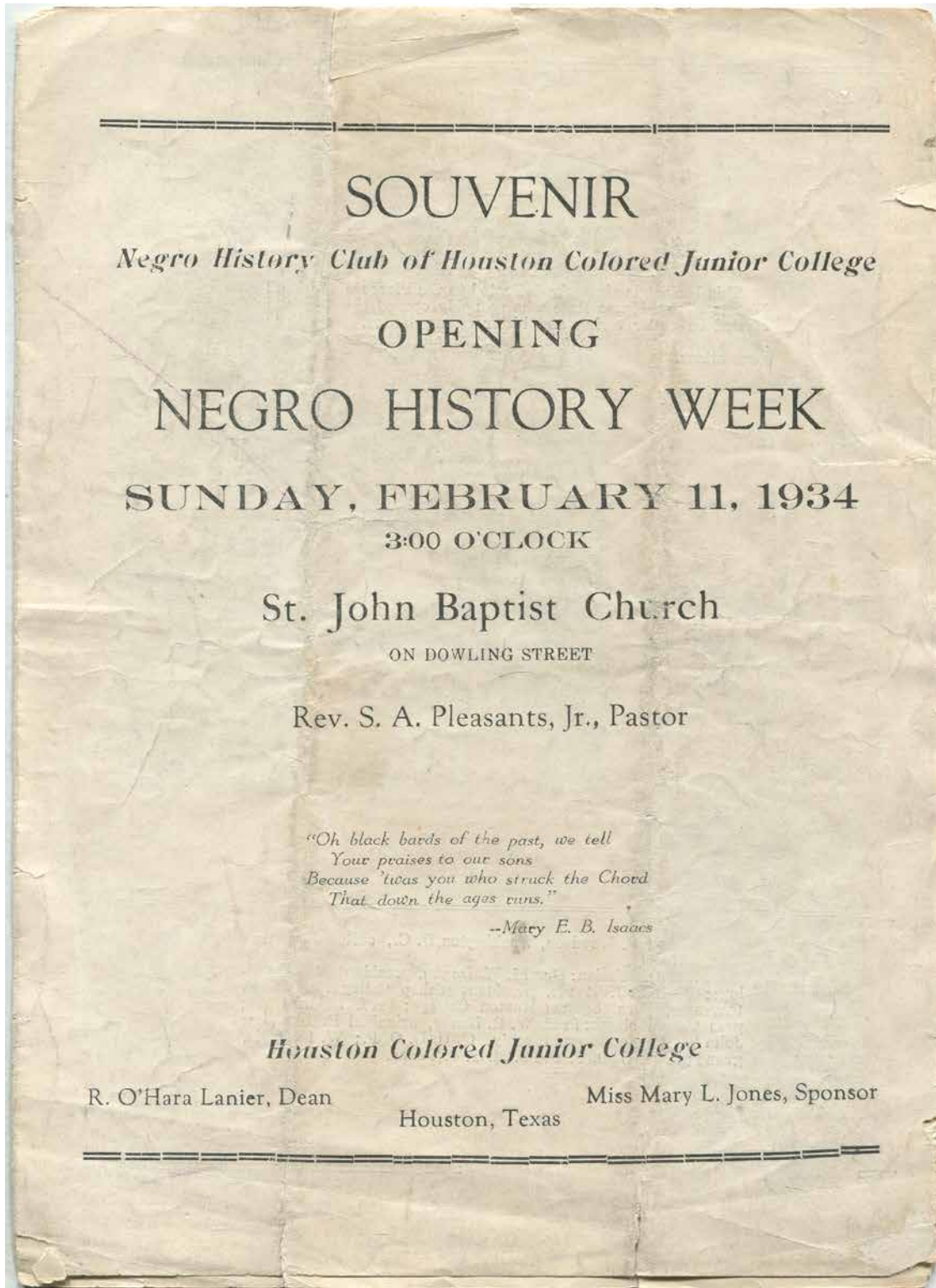


[Cover title]: *Souvenir. Negro History Club of Houston Colored Junior College Opening Negro History Week. Sunday, February 11, 1934*
