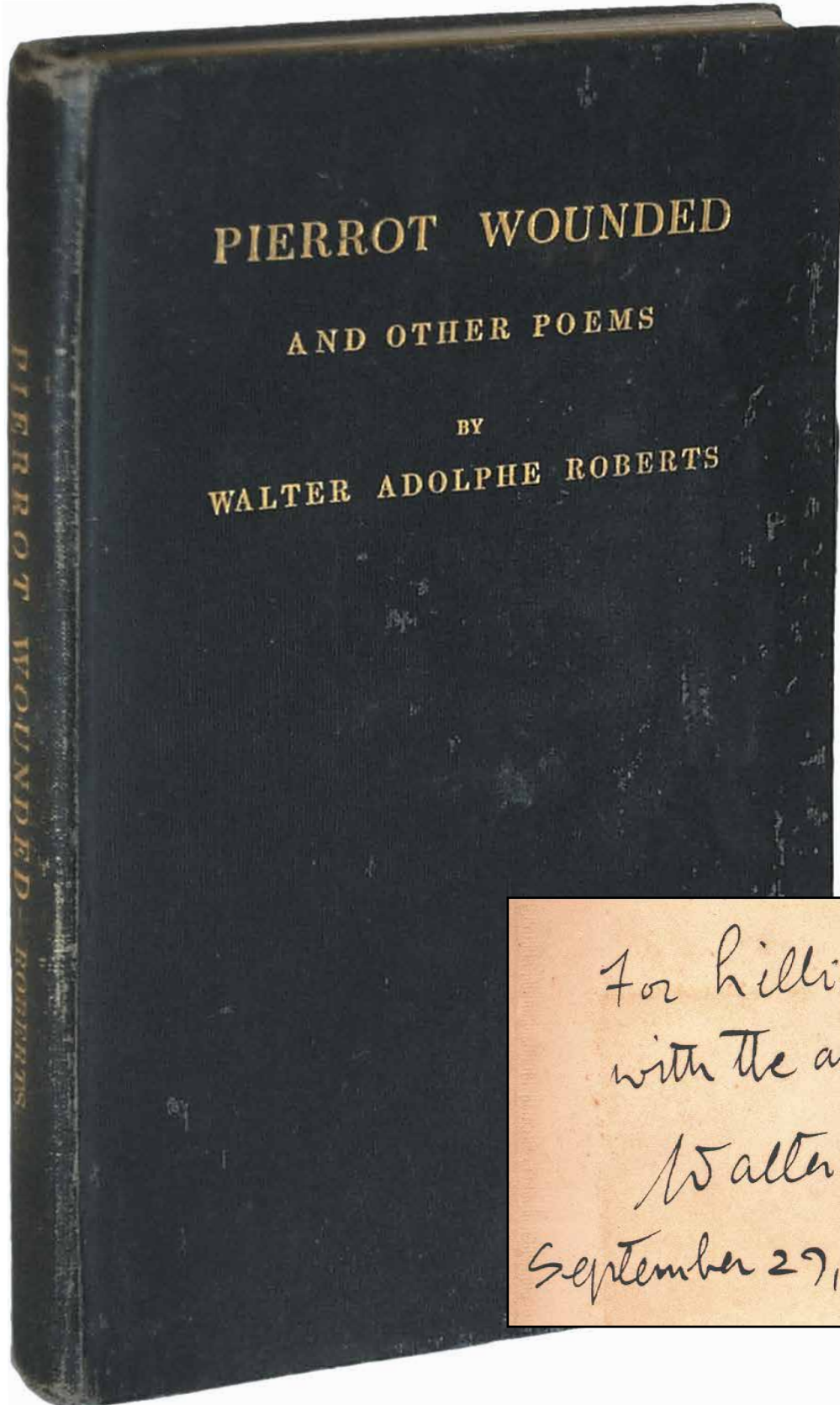



The author's rare first book, a volume of poetry, accompanied by a few translations into English of poems by European poets.
