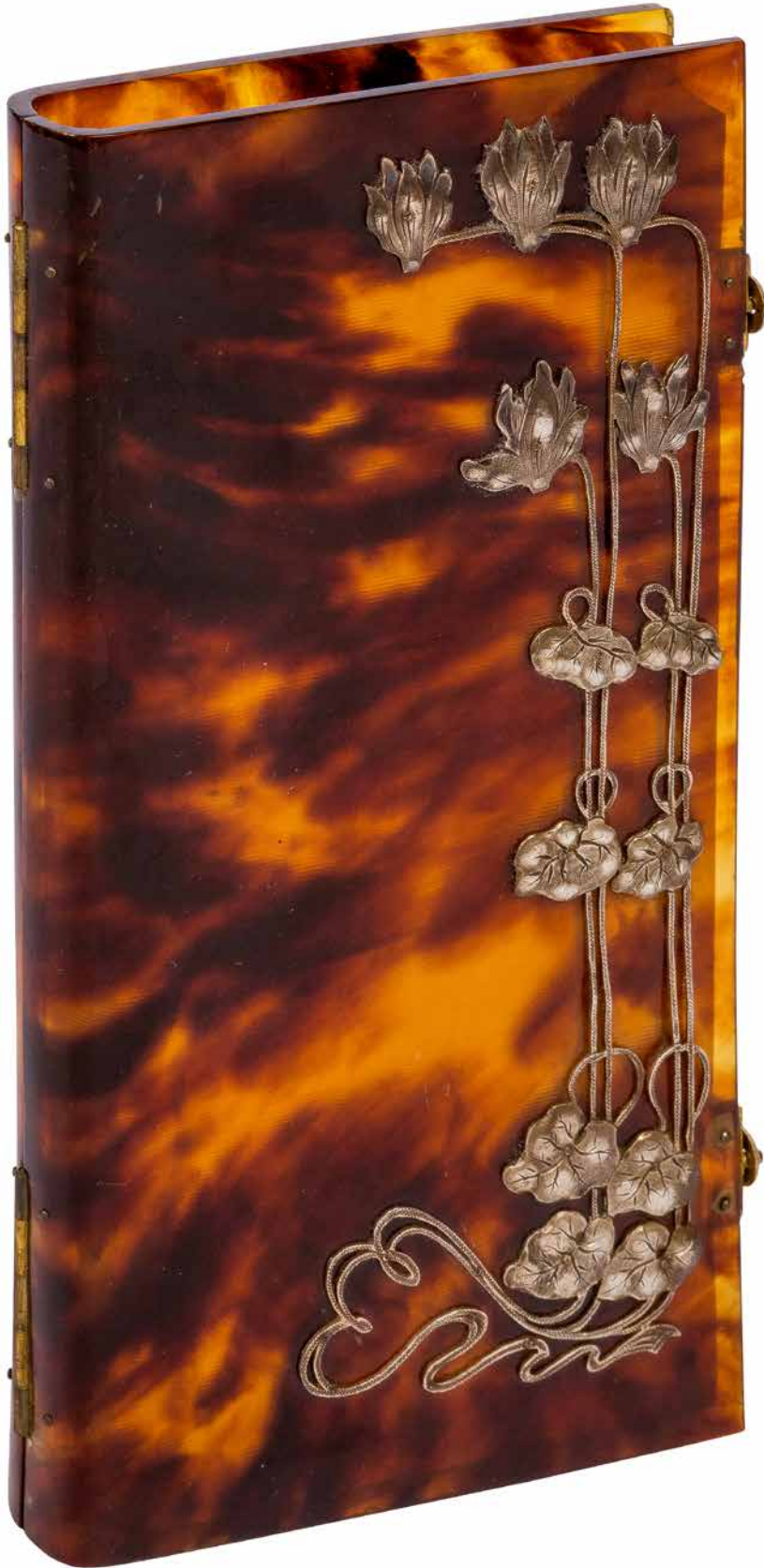

Illustrated with chromolithographic plates with tissue guards, including the frontispiece, with a half-title printed on the recto of the frontispiece plate: "El Oficio del Domingo / No. 316." Imprint on verso of title page is dated 17 October, 1899, printed by G.F.J. Bouvry. Bound in contemporary white silk over card covers, all edges gilt. A beautifully printed devotional manual, neatly mounted inside a tortoise shell Bakelite binding with a sterling silver art nouveau design mounted on the front cover. The Bakelite binding has two brass hinges on the spine back and two brass clasps. Bakelite, the first plastic made from synthetic components, was developed by the Belgian-American chemist Leo Baekeland in 1907 and patented on December 7, 1909. Modest toning to the tissue guards, a fine copy in a fine early Bakelite book binding, likely made in 1910, featuring a fine high art nouveau silver design. [\[BTC#437835\]](#)
